



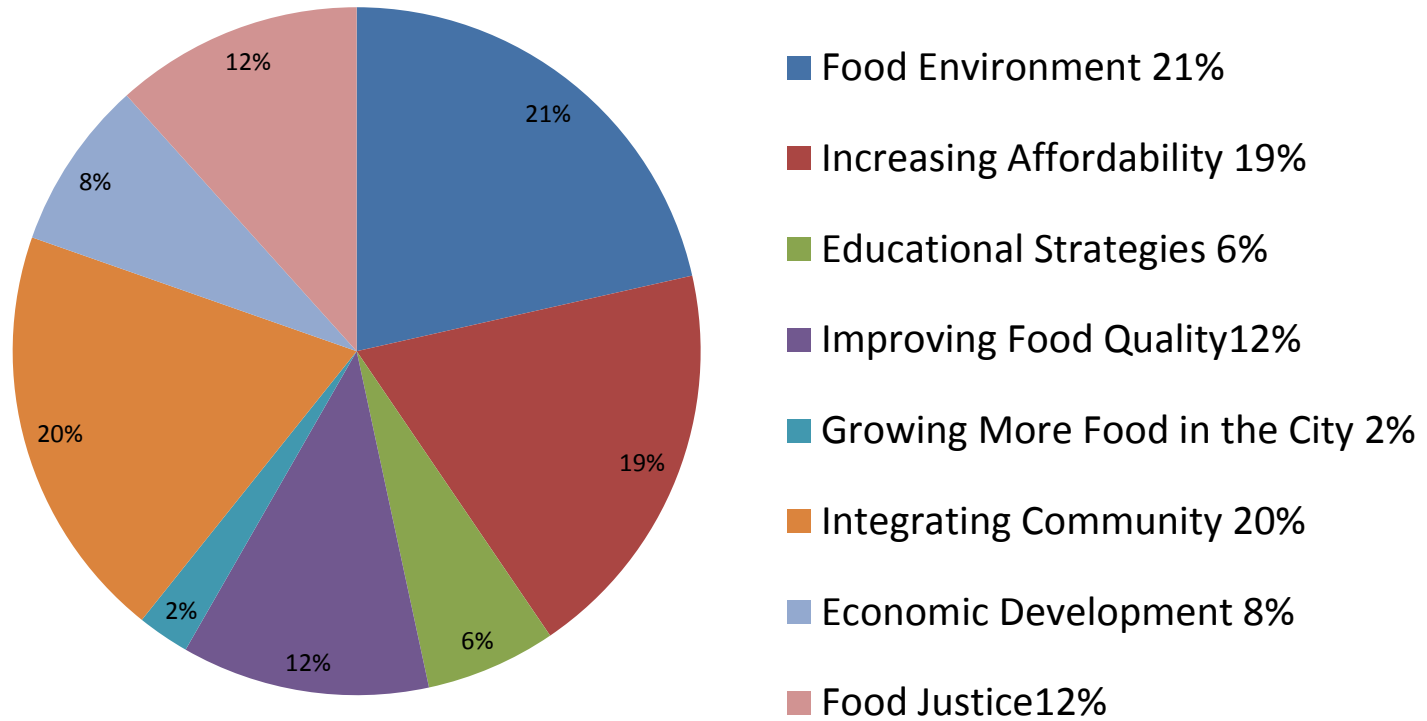

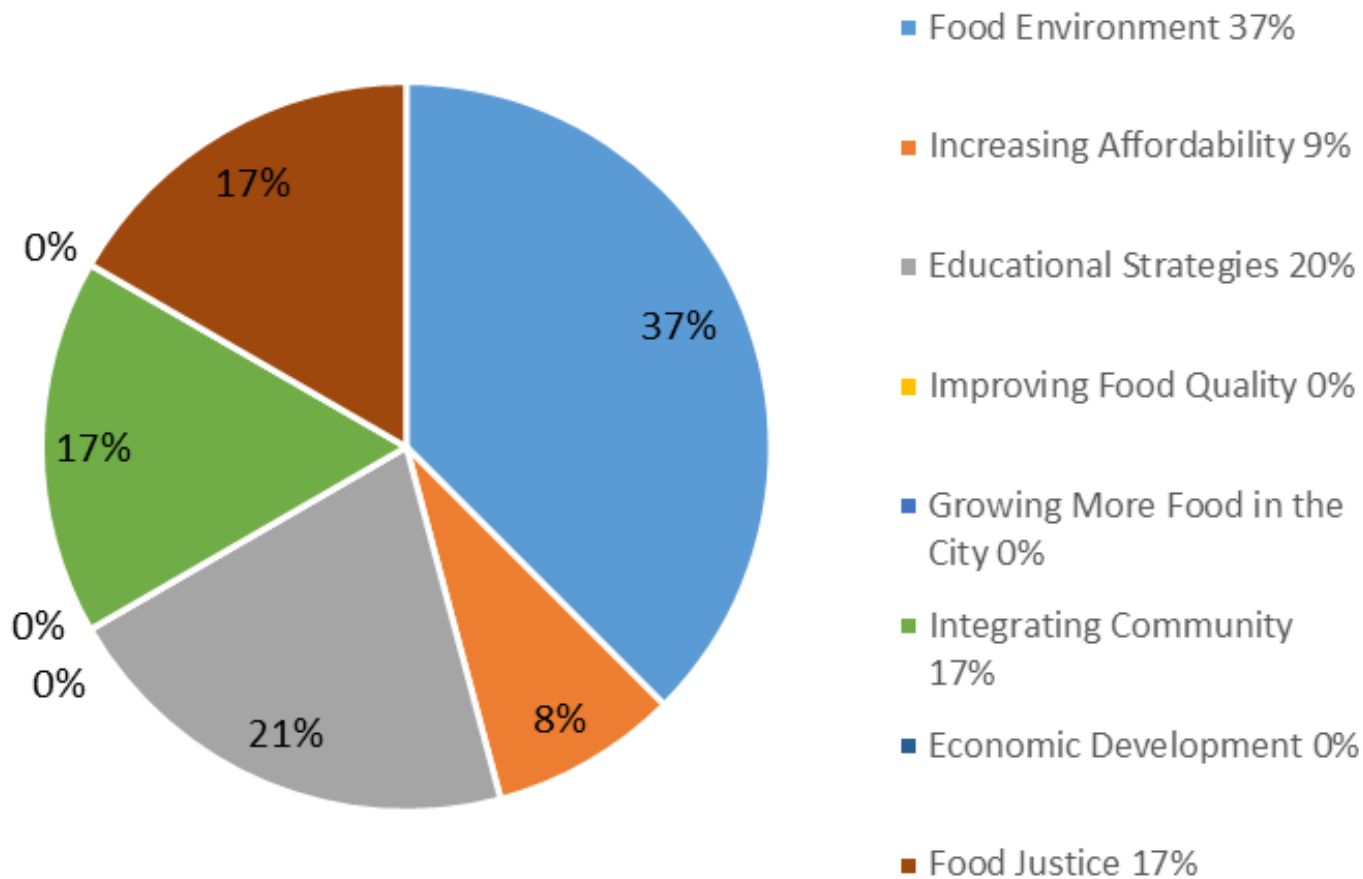
Grand Total Survey Responses (163)

Grand Total of Question 2 of MFC Collective Impact Survey

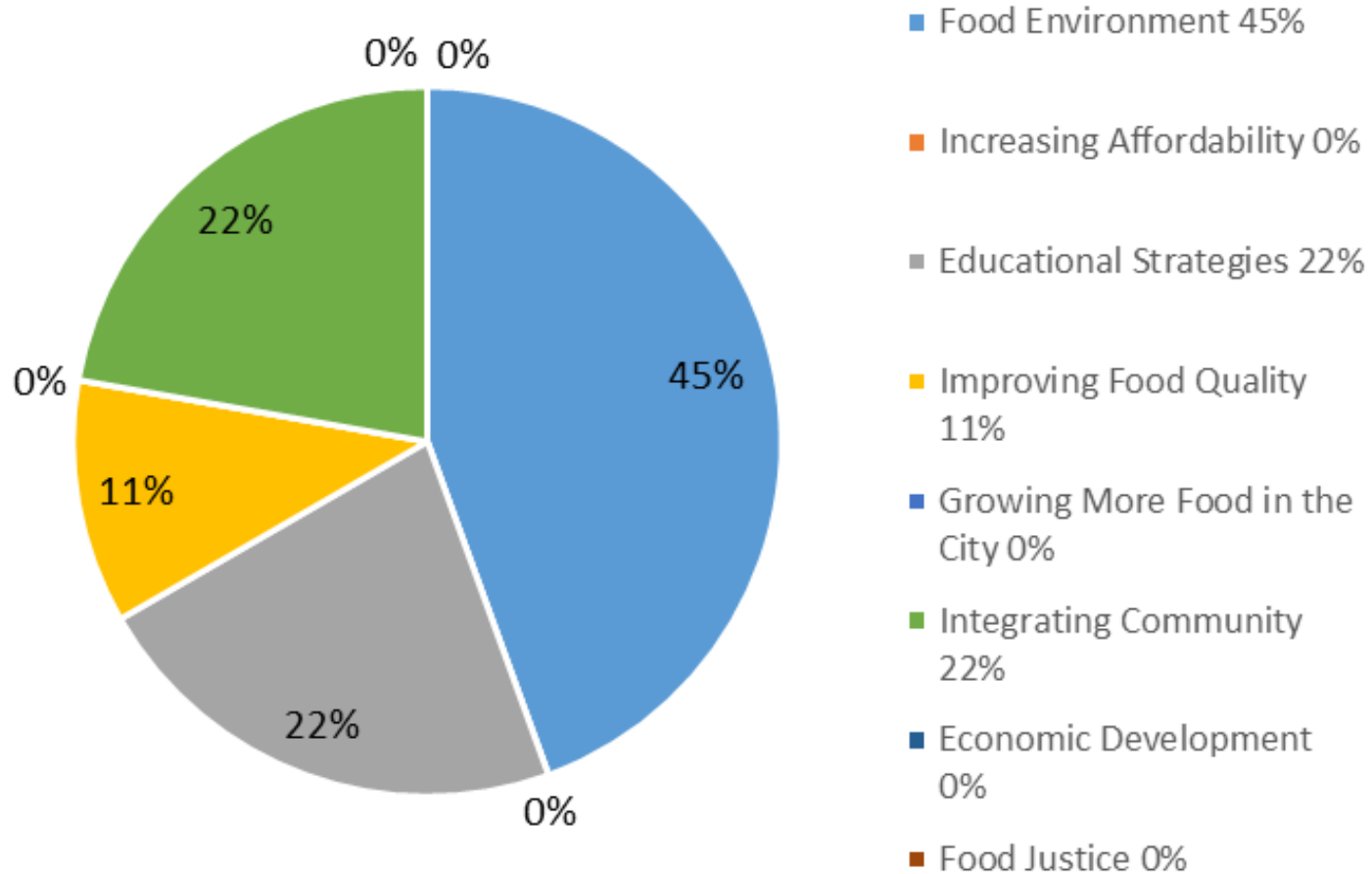

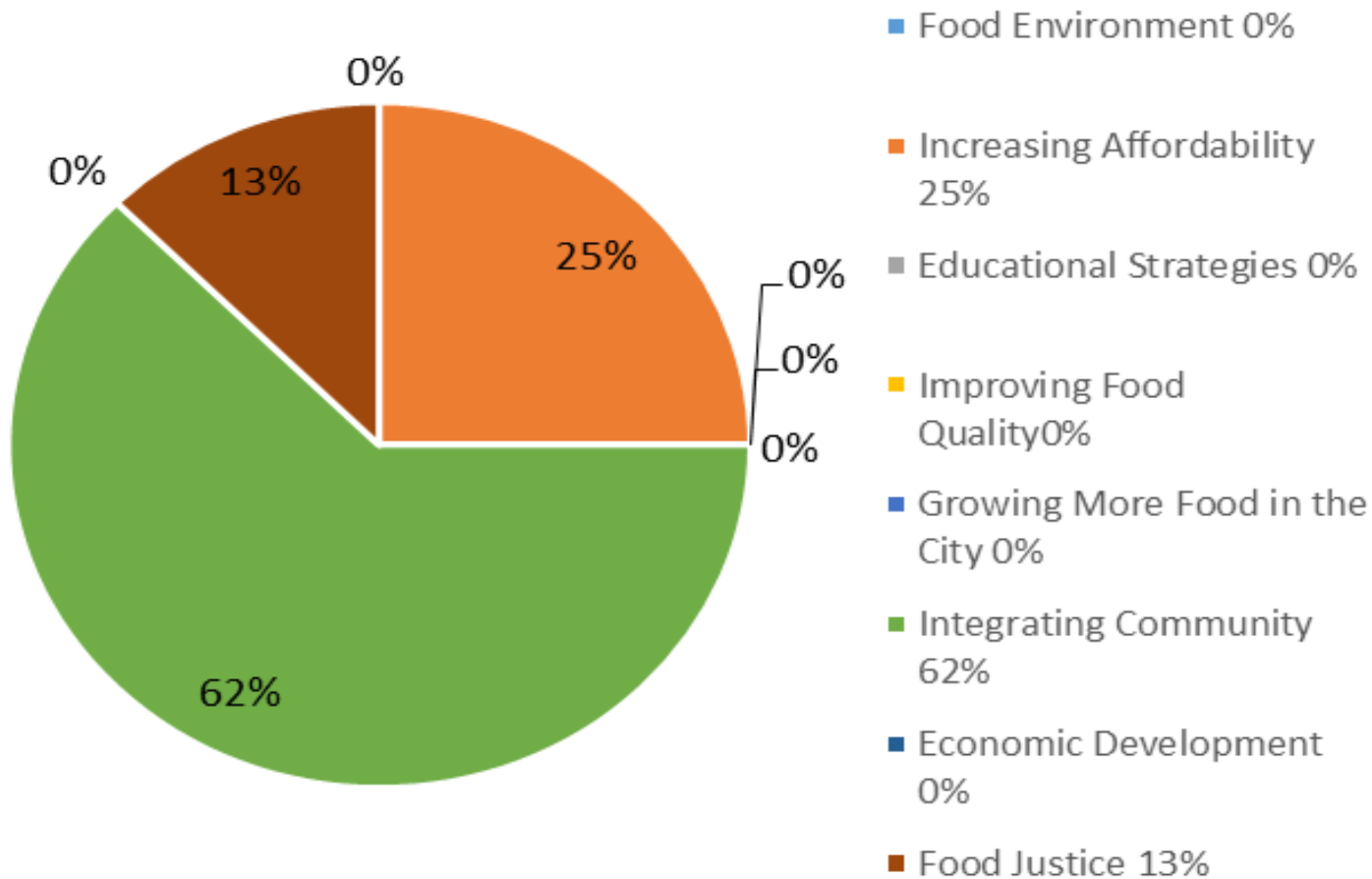

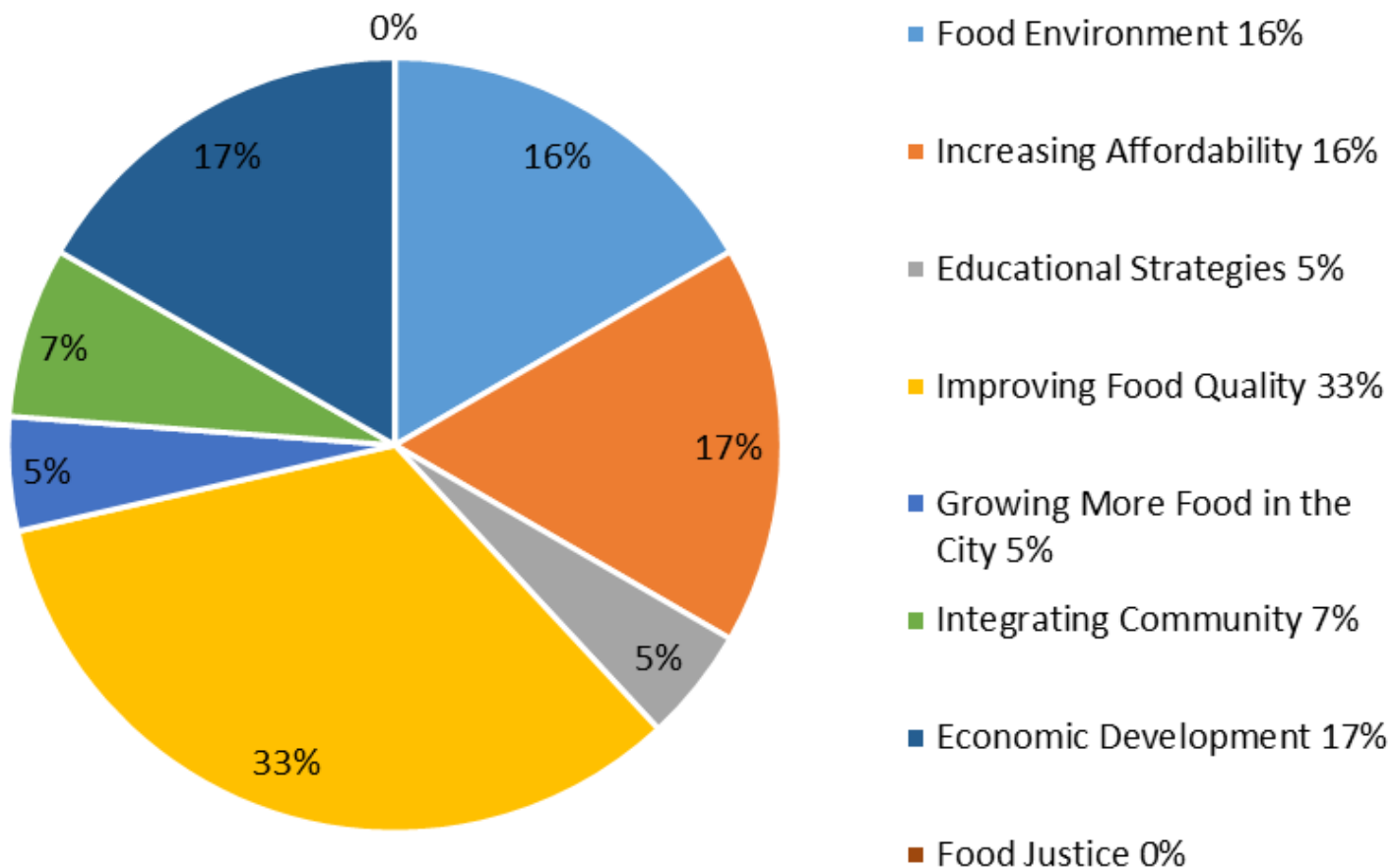

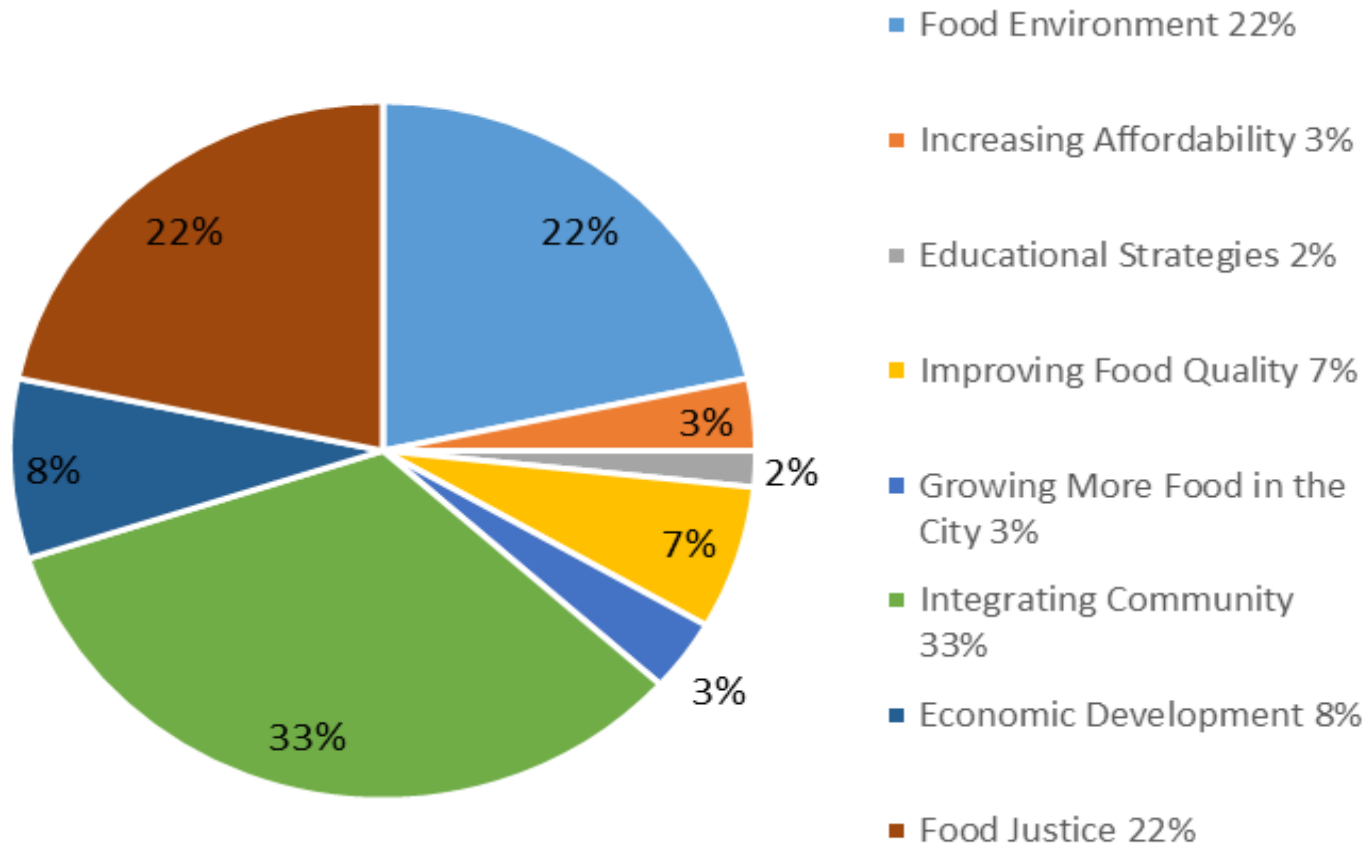

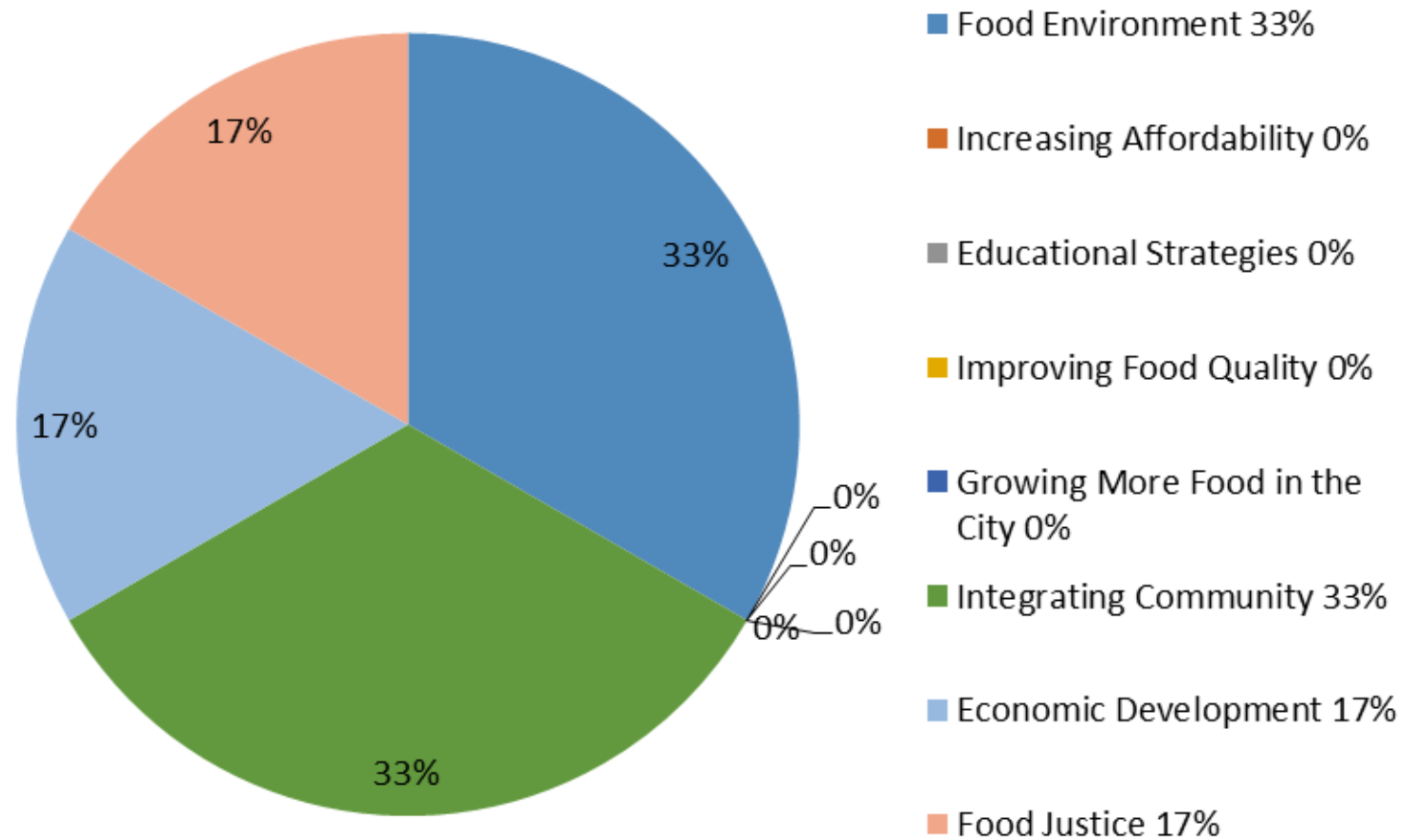

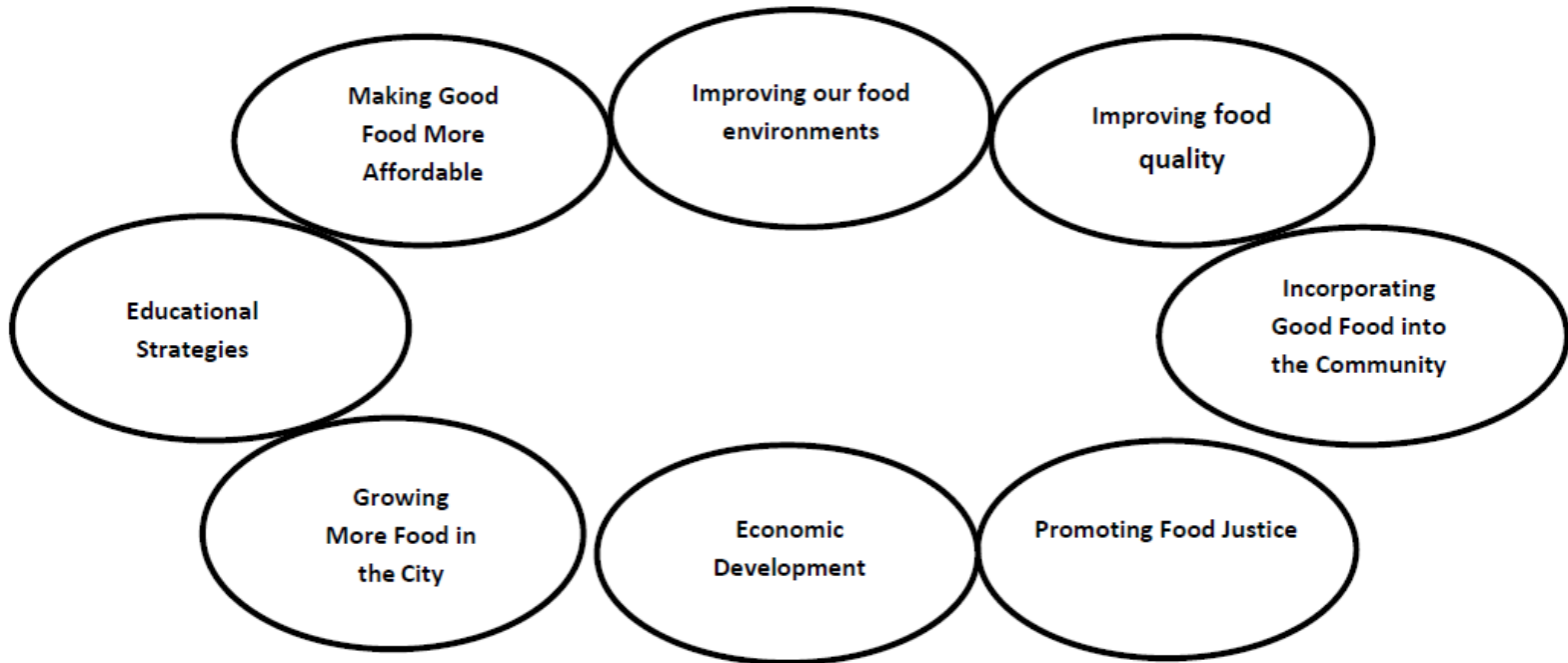
