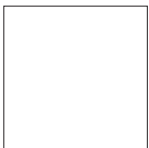

My name is Jeff Mangar. I am running for Superior Court Judge on the March 3 ballot.

I have dedicated my professional life to public service and have been a prosecutor in Stanislaus County since 1998. At the District Attorney's Office, I have been lead attorney on thousands of cases. I've conducted 60 jury trials, including six murder jury trials that involved special circumstances, arson or gangs. In addition to working on the Homicide Team, I was in charge of the Aggravated White Collar Crime/ Real Estate Fraud Unit, where I gained experience in civil, probate, business transactions and family law.

I am the only judicial candidate certified as a Criminal Law legal specialist - an important distinction given the judicial workload here. In 2019, there were 173 jury trials in Stanislaus County. All but five of them were criminal cases. It's important that the next judge has deep experience in that arena.

I am in court on a daily basis. My level of knowledge and daily exposure to our courtrooms is invaluable and necessary when seeking a judgeship.

As a judge, I will continue to serve our community by protecting the rights and safety of citizens of Stanislaus County. I will be a tough, fair and decisive judge.
