About a year ago, I was being released from jail, pregnant, fresh out of active addiction. Today, I have a beautiful daughter who I am 100% present for. I also got my license back, bought myself a brand-new car, graduated drug court, and I have a job working as an outreach worker for Oxford House, Inc. It is incredibly difficult starting over with nothing, and the Yavapai Reentry Project helps you take the necessary steps to rebuild.
