

GREATER EL PASO CHAPTER OF CCIM SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

1. Applicant must be a paid member of the Greater El Paso CCIM Chapter during the year in which the applicant seeks scholarship funds, individual member (\$125/Year) or a corporate member (\$375/Year) and be a candidate of CCIM National Institute. Being a candidate of the Institute is one of the most important steps that a commercial real estate professional can make in his or her career. A candidate is a dues-paying member of the CCIM Institute and is taking courses and/or pursuing the CCIM designation. 2. Preference given for Classes taken in our market. Preference will be given to applicants taking classes hosted in market by the Greater El Paso CCIM Chapter. Taking online and out of market classes does not disqualify applicant however this may lessen the applicant's opportunity to be awarded the subject scholarship.

3. Preference given for Greater El Paso CCIM Chapter applicants with Committee Involvement. Priority is given to those applicants that serve on or commit to serving on a Greater El Paso CCIM Committee.

4. Fill in applicant information below and submit it to the Scholarship Committee for consideration of the scholarship reimbursement award. Submit this form along with the "Certificate of Completion" for your completed core courses that the CCIM Institute will post to your individual member console at www.ccim.com. After you have "successfully" completed two CI Core Courses with a passing score within the past 18-month period, you will be eligible to receive \$900 (\$450 each course). Thereafter, an additional scholarship application may be submitted after each additional successfully completed core class for an additional \$900 (\$450 each course), and up to \$1,800. **Scholarships are based on the availability of scholarship funds** and are only awarded if you meet the above criteria and guidelines as set by the Greater El Paso CCIM Chapter Board of Directors. The Chapter scholarships are awarded to members who have paid for their core classes; national scholarships supersede local scholarships. Recipients of national scholarships for one or more core courses are not eligible for additional reimbursement for that class. Chapter scholarships are subject to change at the sole discretion of the Chapter Board of Directors on a year by year basis and as funds are available. There are two (2) submission periods each year. Applications may be submitted at any time during the submission period but are due no later than March 31st for consideration during the 1st submission period of the year, and August 31st to be considered for the 2nd and final submission period of the year. Applicants will be notified no later than April 15th and September 15th respectively for the 1st and 2nd submission periods.
