I use the following grading percentages:

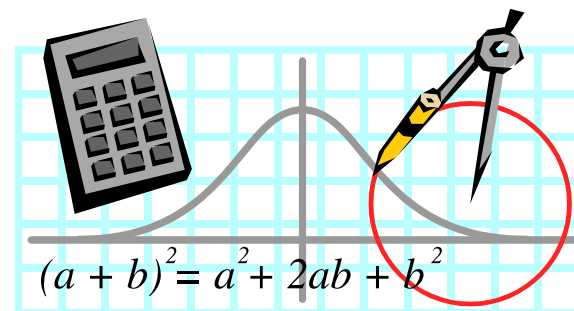
• Tests/projects	40%

Chapter Tests will always be announced and students will have time to review and practice for the test. We will have at least one quiz every week. Homework might be assigned daily.

$$\int \frac{x+5}{x^2-2x-3} dx$$
$$\frac{5}{3} dx = \int \frac{2}{x-3} dx - \int \frac{1}{x+1} dx$$
$$= 2 \ln(x-3) - \ln(x+1) + C$$
$$= \ln \frac{(x-3)^2}{x+1} + C$$
