## **RULES**

The Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé (hereinafter "the Caisse") wishes to encourage all its current and future student members to pursue their studies in the health care sector. We are committed to providing them with financial support to help them achieve their career goals.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for the « Coup de pouce santé » (hereinafter referred to as the Program), a student must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
  - Be a full-time or part-time student in a health-related vocational training, college or university program
  - Be a full member of the Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé at the time of registration and be 18 years of age or older on the Program start date
  - Have a primary residence in Quebec
  - Agree to receive the scholarship fund in the winning member's account at the Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé
  - Development seminars or workshops are not recognized
1. The statement that in all cases, the persons specified in section 3 must, as a minimum, be excluded;
  2. Reference to the following text: "Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the board only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement";
  3. The person for whom a publicity contest is held, as well as their employee, director, representative, agent or jury member, may not participate in the contest.

### **HOW TO ENTER**

To enter the program, an eligible person must:

- Be a student during the 2019 summer and fall term or the 2020 winter, summer or fall term in a post-secondary institution
- Be a member of the Caisse

- Complete the entry form available on the Caisse's website, under the contests and scholarships section ([www.caissesante.ca](http://www.caissesante.ca)) and correctly answer the mathematical skill-testing question
- Be able to provide a transcript or proof of tuition fee payment upon request

- The form must be received by the Caisse no later than **July 31, 2020 at 4 p.m**
- Limit of one entry per eligible participant
- The submission of an entry form entitles the applicant to one entry in the draw on August 7, 2020.

### **PRIZES**

Ten (10) scholarships will be awarded on August 7, 2020 worth a grand total of 10 000 \$:

- Vocational training: two (2) scholarships worth \$500 each to be won
  - Collegial training: four (4) scholarships worth \$750 each to be won
  - University training: four (4) scholarships worth \$1,500 each to be won
- The amount of the scholarship will be deposited in the account of the winning member at the Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé
  - The winning member agrees to take a photo and agrees that it may be used by the Caisse for marketing purposes.

### **DRAW**

- Winners will be picked randomly in a manual draw held on August 7, 2020 at the Caisse.
- The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received during the entire duration of the Program.
- After the draw, all entries will be kept in the event of disqualification.
- The Scholarship total will be deposited into the account of the winning member at the Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé.

## **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

1. In order to be declared a winner, each person selected must:
  - Be contacted by telephone or by e-mail by a Caisse advisor within thirty (30) days following the draw.
  - Confirm that they are or were a student during the Scholarship Program registration period.
  - Agree to have their photo taken at the Caisse in order to highlight the presentation of the cheque.Sign the Declaration and Waiver of Liability Form (hereinafter referred to as the "Declaration Form").

If any of the conditions mentioned above or any other conditions mentioned herein are not met, the selected individual will be disqualified and a new draw for this prize will be held in accordance with these rules until a participant is selected and declared the winner of the prize. The same conditions will remain applicable by making the necessary adjustments.

2. If the selected person refuses to receive the prize, the Caisse will be released from any obligation in connection with the presentation of the prize and may, at its discretion, redraw the prize as described in this document.
3. Anyone participating in the Program agrees to abide by these rules and by the final decisions made by the Caisse administering the Program.
4. The Caisse reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Program, in part or in whole, in the event that any event or any human intervention occurs which may alter or influence the administration, safety, impartiality or implementation of the Program as set out in these rules. In such a case, it cannot be held liable.
5. In the event that, for any reason, entries in the Program are no longer accepted in part or in whole before the end date set out in these rules, the draw may be held at the discretion of the Caisse among the entries duly registered and received until the new end date.
6. In no case will the Caisse be required to assign more prizes or to assign a prize other than in accordance with these rules.
7. Prizes must be accepted as they are written in these rules and shall not be exchanged, substituted for any other prize or transferred to any other person except as provided herein.

8. The winners release the Caisse from any and all liability for damages that may result from their entry in the Program, and the acceptance and use of the prize.

Winners acknowledge that upon receipt of the call or email confirming their prize, the fulfillment of the prize obligations becomes the entire and exclusive responsibility of the various product and service providers. Winners agree to sign a Declaration and Waiver of Liability Form for this purpose and to take an official photo.

9. All entries and declaration forms may be subject to verification by the Caisse. Forms that are incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, duplicated, tampered, fraudulent or submitted or transmitted late with an invalid or otherwise non-compliant telephone number, may be rejected and will not be eligible for the prize.
10. The Caisse will not be responsible for lost, misdirected or late entries, including those due to a postal service issues.
11. The Caisse will not assume any liability whatsoever in the event that its inability to act is the result of a situation or event beyond its control, a strike, lockout or any other labour dispute in its establishments or those of the companies or organizations whose services are used for the Program.
12. By accepting the prize, the winner authorizes the Caisse to use, if necessary, their name, photograph, image, voice and statement about the prize for publicity purposes, without any form of compensation.
13. The personal information collected on participants may be used in various communications unrelated to this Program.
14. Entry and declaration forms are the property of the Caisse and will not be returned to participants under any circumstances.
15. If any paragraph of these rules is declared or deemed illegal, unenforceable or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then that paragraph shall be considered invalid, but all other unaffected shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.
