410.7.3 DRIVEWAY CULVERTS WHERE A PROPOSED DRIVEWAY CROSSES A ROADSIDE DITCH OR SWALE, WHERE FEASIBLE A CULVERT SHALL BE USED TO CONDUCT DRAINAGE UNDER THE DRIVEWAY. THE DESIGN OF THE CULVERT SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ERIE COUNTY STORM WATER AND EROSION CONTROL MANUAL AND SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ERIE COUNTY DRAINAGE SUPERINTENDENT. SEE BELOW.

• DRIVEWAY CULVERTS, FOR CROSSING A ROADSIDE DITCH WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ACCESS A PROPERTY, MUST BE CONTRUCTED OF REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE (RCP) OF NOT LESS THAT 12 INCHES IN DIAMETER AND HAVING A MINIMUM LENGTH OF 32 FEET.

410.9.3 DRIVEWAY MATERIALS WITHIN ROADWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAY

410.9.3.1 ROADWAY WITH NO CURB DRIVEWAYS CONNECTING TO ROADWAYS WITH NO CURBS SHALL HAVE SURFACE MATERIALS OF EITHER ASPHALT CONCRETE OR CRUSHED AGGREGATE WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE ROADWAY EDGE OF PAVEMENT. <u>PORTLAND CEMENT</u> CONCRETE SHALL NOT BE USED WITHIN 10 FEET OF ROADWAY EDGE OF PAVEMENT.

IF THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE ROADWAY WILL RESULT IN DRIVEWAY CONCRETE WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE ROADWAY EDGE OF PAVEMENT, THE DRIVEWAY MAY BE RECONSTRUCTED AS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN THE 10-FOOT MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, SUBJECT TO RIGHT-OF-WAY CONSTRAINTS.
