

# Mount Vernon Academy AHERA Management Plan

**Dear parents, students, teachers, and employees of Mount Vernon Academy,**

As a private non-profit school, Mount Vernon Academy is required to be in compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). Mount Vernon Academy has been working with this agency, as well as the Department of Air Quality (DAQ) for over 25 years to ensure that our students and staff are not at any health risk related to air quality. There is not an area in our buildings that has been identified as an air-quality threat to our students, faculty, and staff. To stay in compliance it is necessary to have an AHERA Management plan. The following is our management plan for the 2014-2015 school year.

- Our management plan consists of six-month periodic surveillance of the property by our Principal and Maintenance Engineer to look for any possible issues relating to air quality.
- Our maintenance engineer has received the proper professional training for these inspections. Any new maintenance engineer will receive the same training.
- We schedule 3-year re-inspections in early spring to identify any new issues that may arise.
- A copy of our Management Plan is available in our school office and also on the school website.
