Member Education and Development Initiatives

Awarded by the Canadian Angus Foundation.

The Canadian Angus Foundation functions to preserve and expand the Angus breed for future generations through education, youth development, scientific and market research, and historical preservation and restoration. The Canadian Angus Foundation was incorporated in 1993 and is the charitable arm of the Canadian Angus Association.

Speaker Sponsorship

The Canadian Angus Foundation (CAF) is committed to member education. The CAF will help off-set the cost of speakers for approved regional events for up to \$750 per event (additional amounts may be considered, based on value). Affiliate associations shall submit a brief application that includes details on the event as well as a budget. Payment will be issued upon receipt of an invoice(s) showing payment to the speaker(s) and a short report on the event, as well as a list of attendees.

Mentorship Travel Bursaries

Canadian Angus Association Mentorship Program participants may apply for a travel bursary to meet with their program partner at a conference or event related to the beef cattle industry. Examples of events may include, but are not limited to, the Canadian Angus National Convention, Beef Improvement Federation Conference, Canadian Beef Industry Conference, Red Angus Association of America National Convention, Beef Leaders Institute, American Angus Association National Convention, National Cattlemen's Beef Association Convention, provincial beef meetings and other approved events.

The annual budget is calendar year, January-December. Awards will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis.

To be considered for the travel award, complete and return this application to the Canadian Angus Foundation at least 15 days before the event you wish to attend. CAA and CAF reserve the right to publish any submitted essay. Please contact Belinda Wagner with application questions.

Applicant qualifications:

1. Applicants must be a member of Canadian Junior Angus or the Canadian Angus Association.
2. Preference will be given to those with a strong connection in the Angus breed.
3. Applicants must be part of the Canadian Angus Association mentorship program.
4. Applicant must maintain a valid Canadian passport if travelling internationally.
5. All applications must be typed. Handwritten applications will not be accepted.
6. Applications must be submitted by email to Belinda Wagner at bwagner@cdnangus.ca with the subject line reading "Foundation Travel Bursaries".
7. A written report will be required within 30 days of the event attended, in order to receive payment.

Complete application to include:

1. Cover sheet with name, contact information, CAA ID number and the event you wish to attend.
2. Résumé to include but not limited to Angus involvement, work history, community activities, school involvement (if applicable) and leadership activities.
3. 250 word essay explaining why you wish to attend the event and what you hope to gain from attending.
4. Provide a budget for the event including expected travel, registration fees, and other expenses you may incur.
