By signing this form, you agree to a meeting with a sales agent to discuss the types of products you initialed above. Please note, the person who will discuss the products is either employed or contracted by a Medicare plan. The person does not work directly for the federal government. STAND-ALONE MEDICARE PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLANS (PART D)
A stand-alone drug plan that adds prescription drug coverage to Original Medicare, some Medicare Cost plans, some Medicare Private Fee-for-Service plans, and Medicare Medical Savings Account plans.
MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLANS (PART C)
A Medicare Advantage plan that provides all Original Medicare Part A and Part B health coverage and sometimes covers Part D prescription drug coverage. In most HMOs, you can only get your care from doctors or hospitals in the plan’s network (except in emergencies).
A Medicare Advantage plan that provides all Original Medicare Part A and Part B health coverage and sometimes covers Part D prescription drug coverage. PPOs have network doctors and hospitals but you can also use out-of-network providers, usually at a higher cost.
A special type of Medicare Advantage Plan available that provides more focused and specialized health care for specific groups of people, such as those who have both Medicare and Medicaid, who reside in a nursing home, or have certain chronic medical conditions. There are plans available to anyone who has both Medical Assistance from the State and Medicare, plans for people with diabetes, and plans for anyone with Medicare living in an assisted living facility (ALF) or living at home but have complex health issues which require comprehensive care.

Scope of Appointment documentation is subject to CMS record retention requirements.

Agent: Ensure correct Scope of Appointment form is selected for beneficiary’s plan enrollment choice.

Anthem-affiliated health plans are Medicare Advantage Organizations and Prescription Drug Plans with a Medicare contract. For Dual-Eligible Special Needs Plans: Anthem-affiliated health plans are a SNP with a Medicare contract and a contract with the state Medicaid program. Enrollment in Anthem-affiliated health plans depends on contract renewal.
