




# Cultivation & Appearance Info

FLNPS plants are donated by our members, who propagate from locally collected seed (wild or garden) and/or divide plants from their own gardens.


**No wild-collected plants are offered for sale.**

**NOTES** – reg or "regular" is equivalent to typical garden soil, watered as needed.  = Good for pollinators  
Spring **Ephemeral**= E (foliage dies back by mid summer)

<i>Actaea pachypoda</i> , doll's eyes, (Poisonous)	white fl, white berry, 20-30"; moist, part sun - shade
<i>Actaea pachypoda var rubra</i> , pink doll's eyes, (Poisonous)	white fl, probably pink berry, 20-30"; moist, part sun - shade
<i>Actaea racemosa/podocarpa</i> , black cohosh; (Cimicifuga) podocarpa=Appalachia	3-6', white, late summer bloom"; part shade, reg soil
<i>Actaea rubra</i> , red baneberry (Poisonous)	white fl, red berry, 20-30"; moist, part sun - shade
<i>Adiantum pedatum</i> , maidenhair fern	deciduous fern 1-2.5'; shade, moist-wet
<i>Ageratina altissima</i> , white snake root (Eupatorium rugosum)	white, 1-3', vigorous spreader; pt-sun/lt shade, moist-dry
<i>Allium cernuum</i> , nodding onion (mid-western source) 	pink, 18"; sun -part sun, moist-dry
<i>Anemone virginiana</i> , thimbleweed	white, 12-30"; dry- reg, sun-shade
<i>Aquilegia canadensis</i> , wild columbine 	yel&red, 10-24"; sun-lt shade, well-drained, acid-neutral soil
<i>Arisaema triphyllum</i> , jack-in-the-pulpit	12-28"; moist, organic soil, shade
<i>Aronia melanocarpa</i> , black chokeberry	shrub, white flowers, black berry ; pt sun-sun, moist-wet
<i>Asclepias incarnata</i> , swamp milkweed 	pink, 2-4'; sun-p shade, reg-wet soil
<i>Asclepias syriaca</i> , common milkweed 	white/pink, 2-4'; sun-p shade, reg-wet soil
<i>Athyrium filix-femina</i> , lady fern	delicate, deciduous, 1-2'; p-shade-shade, moist-dry
<i>Blephilia ciliata</i> , downy wood mint, midwestern (historic in FL)	pink - mauve, 24-30"; sun- p shade, moist - dry
<i>Caltha palustris</i> , marsh marigold	yellow, 10-12"; moist-wet, sun - pt sun
<i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> , harebell	blue, 6"; well-drained, moist- dry pt shade
<i>Cardamine concatenata</i> , lance-leaved toothwort (Dentaria) <u>E</u>	white, 6", ephemeral; shade-pt shade, dry-regular 
<i>Carex comosa</i> , bristly sedge	2.5-3' tall, large "caterpillar" fruit; sun-pt sun, wet muck or sandy soil
<i>Carex grayi</i> , Asa Grey's sedge , (scarce)	2-3', large spiny seedhead; pt sun, reg soil
<i>Chelone glabra</i> , white turtlehead 	white, 2-3'; sun-pt shade, moist-wet
<i>Cirsium pumilum</i> , pasture thistle 	1-3' ht, 2-3" pink flower ANNUAL; native to dry, sunny meadows
<i>Clematis virginiana</i> , virgin's bower	white fall flowering vine; moist, sun - part sun
<i>Cornus florida</i> , flowering dogwood	white fl, red berries, small tree; p shade - sun, reg- moist
<i>Cornus sericea</i> , red-osier dogwood	white fl & berries, shrub, new growth red; pt shade-sun, reg-moist
<i>Cystopteris bulbifera</i> , bulblet fern	lacy, 12" drooping fronds, "bulbs" under leaves; shade, moist-dry, well drained
<i>Dicentra canadensis</i> , squirrel corn <u>E</u>	white ephemeral, 3-5"; shade - part sun, moist, rich soil
<i>Dicentra cucularia</i> , Dutchman's-breeches <u>E</u>	white ephemeral, 3-5"; shade - part sun, moist, rich soil
<i>Diplazium pycnocarpon</i> , narrow leaved glade fern	clumps, slender fronds 1.5-3.5'; rich forest & shale, lime, shade
<i>Dirca palustris</i> , leatherwood	shrub, fragrant inconspicuous flowers; rich soil, p shade
<i>Dryopteris goldiana</i> , Goldie's fern (scarce)	24", deciduous fern; shade-pt sun, regular-moist
<i>Dryopteris intermedia</i> , evergreen wood fern	12-18", evergreen fern; shade, moist
<i>Elymus canadensis</i> , prairie wild rye	grass, blue-grn leaf, 2-3' ; dry-wet, pt shade-sun

<i>Erythronium americanum</i> , trout lily	<b>E</b>	(ephemeral), yellow, spotted lvs; shade-p sun, reg-moist
<i>Eurybia divaricata</i> , white wood aster		white, 1-2' ; moist-dry, sun-shade
<i>Eutrochium sp.</i> , Joe Pye (butterflies!)		pink, 5-8'; sun - p shade, moist-regular soil
<i>Geranium maculatum</i> , wild geranium		pink, 12-18"; sun - lt shade, moist soil (in spring)
<i>Iris versicolor</i> , blue flag		blue-violet, 3-4'; sun, moist - wet soil
<i>Lobelia siphilitica</i> , great blue lobelia (Biennial -must reseed!)		Blue or White, 2-3'; sun-pt sun, 2-3';moist- wet
<i>Lysimachia ciliata</i> , fringed loosestrife		yellow, 2-4'; pt sun, moist-wet
<i>Maianthemum racemosum</i> , Solomon's plume, (Smilacina)		1-3', white, pink-red berries; moist-reg, part sun-shade
<i>Maianthemum stellatum</i> , starry Solomon's plume (Smilacina)		1-3', white flowers, pink berries w/2 different clones ; moist, part sun-shade
<i>Matteuccia struthiopteris</i> , ostrich fern		erect, large fern; prominent fertile frond; moist-dry, shade-pt sun
<i>Mertensia virginica</i> , Virginia bluebells		blue/pink ephemeral, 14-20"; pt sun - shade; moist in spring
<i>Mimulus ringens</i> , Monkey Flower		bl-violet, 2-4'; moist-wet, sun-p sun
<i>Monarda fistulosa</i> , "wild bergamot, bee balm"		violet, 3-4'; sun-lt shade, moist-reg
<i>Oenothera biennis</i> , evening primrose		yel, 3'; sun, moist-dry
<i>Onoclea sensibilis</i> , sensitive fern (Poisonous to livestock)		18-24", distinctive spore frond; reg-wet, shade-pt sh
<i>Packera aurea</i> , golden ragwort		yellow, low groundcover w/15-18" flower stalk; sun- pt shade, dry-moist
<i>Parthenium integrifolium</i> , wild quinine		white, 4'; sun, dry-medium soil
<i>Penstemon hirsutus</i> , hairy beardtongue		pur/white, 2'; reg-dry, sun
<i>Quercus rubra</i> , red oak		large tree; sun- pt sun, regular soil
<i>Rosa carolina</i> , pasture rose		pink, 2-3', stoloniferous; sun-pt shade, dry-moist
<i>Rosa palustris</i> , swamp rose		pink, 2-6', stoloniferous; sun-pt sun, moist, acid-neutral soil
<i>Rosa setigera</i> , prairie rose		pink, 5-8'; sun-pt sun, regular-dry
<i>Rubus odoratus</i> , purple-flowering raspberry		pink, shrub, edible fruit, spreads; dry-moist; sun- pt shade
<i>Rudbeckia laciniata</i> , cut-leaved coneflower		yellow, 4-6'; sun, wet - dry soil
<i>Rudbeckia triloba</i> , black-eyed susan (Native East 1/2 U.S.)		yellow, 2-3'; sun, reg-moist soil
<i>Sambucus canadensis</i> , common elderberry		white fl, edible blue fruit, shrub to 7?; sun, reg soil
<i>Sanguinaria canadensis</i> , bloodroot (sometimes <b>E</b> )		white, 6", spring ephemeral; neutral soil, pt shade
<i>Solidago caesia</i> , wreath goldenrod		1.5-4', yel flower all along stem; dry-moist, sun -shade (can take dry shade!)
<i>Solidago flexicaulis</i> , zig-zag goldenrod		1-4', yellow clusters; moist-dry, sun -shade, likes woodland
<i>Spirea sp.</i> , meadow sweet		shrub to 6', white fl ; sun, moist-wet, rich organic soil
<i>Symphyotrichum laeve</i> , smooth blue aster		Lavender, 1-3? ; sun -pt sh, reg - dry, well drained, likes lime
<i>Symphyotrichum lowrianum</i> , Lowries's aster		violet,1-3'; moist-dry, sun-pt shade
<i>Symphyotrichum novae-angliae</i> , New England aster		pink to violet/purple, 2-6';; moist, sun -part sun
<i>Symphyotrichum novae-angliae</i> (ex-pink), New England aster		pink to violet/purple, 2-6';; moist, sun -part sun
<i>Symphyotrichum prenanthoides</i> , zig-zag aster		blue/lavender, 24-30"; moist & p-full sun OR part shade if dry
<i>Symphyotrichum urophyllum</i> , arrow leaved aster		white, 2-3'; dry, sun -part sun
<i>Thalictrum dioicum</i> , early meadow rue		yel-grn; 1-3', attractive leaves; pt sun-shade; moist in spring
<i>Tiarella cordifolia</i> , foam flower		white, 6-8"; shade-pt shade, dry-moist, well drained
<i>Trillium erectum</i> , red trillium		red, 10-12"; shade-pt shade, rich moist soil
<i>Trillium grandiflorum</i> , white trillium		white, 10-12"; shade-pt shade, rich moist soil
<i>Viola sororia</i> , common violet		purple or white flowered; moist -dry soil, pt shade - sun
<i>Viola sororia white</i> , common violet		purple or white flowered; moist -dry soil, pt shade - sun
<i>Zizia aurea</i> , golden alexanders, (early butterflies!)		yel, 1- 3', self sows; sun-lt shade; moist- wet

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
