- ✓ K-12 Educators – papers submitted for presentation, potential inclusion in Proceedings upon acceptance, and consideration for best conference paper awards.

Student Papers and Posters: Abstracts of 500 words or less must be submitted electronically through the online submission system. Who can submit:

- ✓ Undergraduate and Graduate Students - papers submitted for presentation at the conference and consideration for best student conference paper awards;
- ✓ Undergraduate Students - research project posters submitted for presentation at the conference and consideration for best undergraduate student conference poster awards;
- ✓ Graduate Students - research project posters submitted for presentation at the conference and consideration for best graduate student conference poster awards.
