

ACCUSE (some of these are repeats because of different translations in the search)

Mat_12:10 (ASV) and behold, a man having a withered hand. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day? that they might accuse him. Jewish leadership

Mar_3:2 (ASV) And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him. Jewish leadership

Mar_15:4 (ASV) And Pilate again asked him, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they accuse thee of. Jewish leadership

Luk_6:7 (ASV) And the scribes and the Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath; that they might find how to accuse him. Jewish leadership

Luk_23:2 (ASV) And they began to accuse him, saying, We found this man perverting our nation, and forbidding to give tribute to Caesar, and saying that he himself is Christ a king. Jewish leadership

Luk_23:14 (ASV) and said unto them, Ye brought unto me this man, as one that perverteth the people: and behold, I having examined him before you, found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him: Jewish leadership

Joh_5:45 (ASV) Think not that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even Moses, on whom ye have set your hope. Moses accusing the Jewish leadership

Joh_8:6 (ASV) And this they said, trying him, that they might have whereof to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground. Jewish leadership

Act_19:38 (ASV) If therefore Demetrius, and the craftsmen that are with him, have a matter against any man, the courts are open, and there are proconsuls: let them accuse one another.

Act_24:2 (ASV) And when he was called, Tertullus began to accuse him, saying, Seeing that by thee we enjoy much peace, and that by the providence evils are corrected for this nation, Jewish leadership's orator

Act_24:8 (ASV) commanding his accusers to come before thee. from whom thou wilt be able, by examining him thyself, to take knowledge of all these things whereof we accuse him.

Act_24:13 (ASV) Neither can they prove to thee the things whereof they now accuse me.

Act_25:5 (ASV) Let them therefore, saith he, that are of power among you go down with me, and if there is anything amiss in

the man, let them accuse him.

Act_25:11 (ASV) If then I am a wrong-doer, and have committed anything worthy of death, I refuse not to die; but if none of those things is true whereof these accuse me, no man can give me up unto them. I appeal unto Caesar.

Act_28:19 (ASV) But when the Jews spake against it, I was constrained to appeal unto Caesar; not that I had aught whereof to accuse my nation.

Mat_12:10 (ESV) And a man was there with a withered hand. And they asked him, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?"—so that they might accuse him.

Mar_3:2 (ESV) And they watched Jesus, to see whether he would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse him.

Luk_6:7 (ESV) And the scribes and the Pharisees watched him, to see whether he would heal on the Sabbath, so that they might find a reason to accuse him.

Luk_23:2 (ESV) And they began to accuse him, saying, "We found this man misleading our nation and forbidding us to give tribute to Caesar, and saying that he himself is Christ, a king."

Joh_5:45 (ESV) Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Moses, on whom you have set your hope.

Act_24:2 (ESV) And when he had been summoned, Tertullus began to accuse him, saying: "Since through you we enjoy much peace, and since by your foresight, most excellent Felix, reforms are being made for this nation,

Act_24:8 (ESV) By examining him yourself you will be able to find out from him about everything of which we accuse him."

Rom_2:15 (ESV) They show that the work of the law is written on their hearts, while their conscience also bears witness, and their conflicting thoughts accuse or even excuse them

Luk_11:54 (KJV) Laying wait for him, and seeking to catch something out of his mouth, that they might accuse him.

1Pe_3:16 (KJV) Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

ACCUSED

Mat_27:12 (ASV) And when he was accused by the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing.

Mar_15:3 (ASV) And the chief priests accused him of many things.

Luk_16:1 (ASV) And he said also unto the

disciples, There was a certain rich man, who had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he was wasting his goods.

Act_19:40 (ASV) For indeed we are in danger to be accused concerning this day's riot, there being no cause for it: and as touching it we shall not be able to give account of this concourse.

Act_22:30 (ASV) But on the morrow, desiring to know the certainty wherefore he was accused of the Jews, he loosed him, and commanded the chief priests and all the council to come together, and brought Paul down and set him before them.

Act_23:28 (ASV) And desiring to know the cause wherefore they accused him, I brought him down unto their council:

Act_23:29 (ASV) whom I found to be accused about questions of their law, but to have nothing laid to his charge worthy of death or of bonds.

Act_25:16 (ASV) To whom I answered, that it is not the custom of the Romans to give up any man, before that the accused have the accusers face to face, and have had opportunity to make his defense concerning the matter laid against him.

Act_26:2 (ASV) I think myself happy, king Agrippa, that I am to make my defense before thee this day touching all the things whereof I am accused by the Jews:

Act_26:7 (ASV) unto which promise our twelve tribes, earnestly serving God night and day, hope to attain. And concerning this hope I am accused by the Jews, O king!

Tit_1:6 (ASV) if any man is blameless, the husband of one wife, having children that believe, who are not accused of riot or unruly.

Mat_27:12 (ESV) But when he was accused by the chief priests and elders, he gave no answer.

Mar_15:3 (ESV) And the chief priests accused him of many things.

Act_22:30 (ESV) But on the next day, desiring to know the real reason why he was being accused by the Jews, he unbound him and commanded the chief priests and all the council to meet, and he brought Paul down and set him before them.

Act_23:29 (ESV) I found that he was being accused about questions of their law, but charged with nothing deserving death or imprisonment.

Act_25:16 (ESV) I answered them that it was not the custom of the Romans to give up anyone before the accused met the accusers face to face and had opportunity to make his defense concerning the charge laid against him.

Act_26:7 (ESV) to which our twelve tribes hope to attain, as they earnestly worship

night and day. And for this hope I am
accused by Jews, O king!

Luk_23:10 (KJV) And the chief priests and
scribes stood and vehemently accused him.

ACCUSER

Rev_12:10 (ASV) And I heard a great voice
in heaven, saying, Now is come the
salvation, and the power, and the kingdom
of our God, and the authority of his
Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is
cast down, who accuseth them before our God
day and night.

Mat_5:25 (ESV) Come to terms quickly with
your accuser while you are going with him
to court, lest your accuser hand you over
to the judge, and the judge to the guard,
and you be put in prison.

Luk_12:58 (ESV) As you go with your accuser
before the magistrate, make an effort to
settle with him on the way, lest he drag
you to the judge, and the judge hand you
over to the officer, and the officer put
you in prison.
