

Community Visioning Session

Bloor/Dundas Visioning Session Meeting #1 Meeting Date: January 16, 2008

1. **Welcome and Introduction (5 min.):** Councillor Gord Perks (Meeting Chair)

2. **Overview (15 min.):** Lynda Macdonald (Manager, Community Planning)
Explanation of current planning framework including 'Avenues' and Mixed Use designation and format for the visioning session.

3. **Working Session (1 hour)**
Participants will move between the three topic tables (Built form/Massing, Streetscape, Transportation) at 20 minute intervals. A staff person will be available at each table helping to keep focus and providing assistance as needed.

Flip paper, a large map and any relevant material will be available at each table. Participants will be asked to use a large map of the area to formulate ideas and identify positives, negatives and opportunities along the Strip. Before each shift, each table will record their collective decisions on the large flip paper to be hung along the wall.

Staff will be available with information and assistance on Community Services and Facilities.

Staff will take the group and individual opinions/comments and use them in their work in determining a vision for the area. Follow-up meeting to be held in February to report back on preliminary findings.
