

# NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE

## Roncesvalles Avenue • Roncesvalles Polish Festival, Sept. 15, 16 2012

Please note that **Roncesvalles Avenue will be closed to traffic from: Saturday, Sept. 15 at 6:00 a.m. until Sunday Sept. 16 at 11:00 p.m. between Dundas Street West and Harvard Avenue** for the 2012 Roncesvalles Polish Festival.



**Howard Park Avenue will remain open to traffic and transit.**



Parking will not be permitted on Roncesvalles during the festival. Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday September 15, **the City of Toronto will conduct a “friendly tow”** of vehicles parked on Roncesvalles Avenue. If your car is on the Festival route, it will be moved to a nearby location at no charge. You will be able to locate your car by phoning 11 Division at 416-808-1100.

There will be **no parking or driving** on Roncesvalles Avenue from: Saturday, September 16 at 6:00 a.m. until Sunday September 18 at 11:00 p.m.



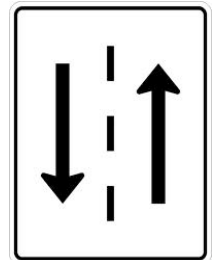
The **504 streetcar will not be operating** on Roncesvalles Avenue during the Festival.

All other transit lines will be unaffected.

All side streets that connect to the Festival route will be blocked at Roncesvalles Avenue. During the Festival, **all affected side streets will be two-way** regardless of signage.
