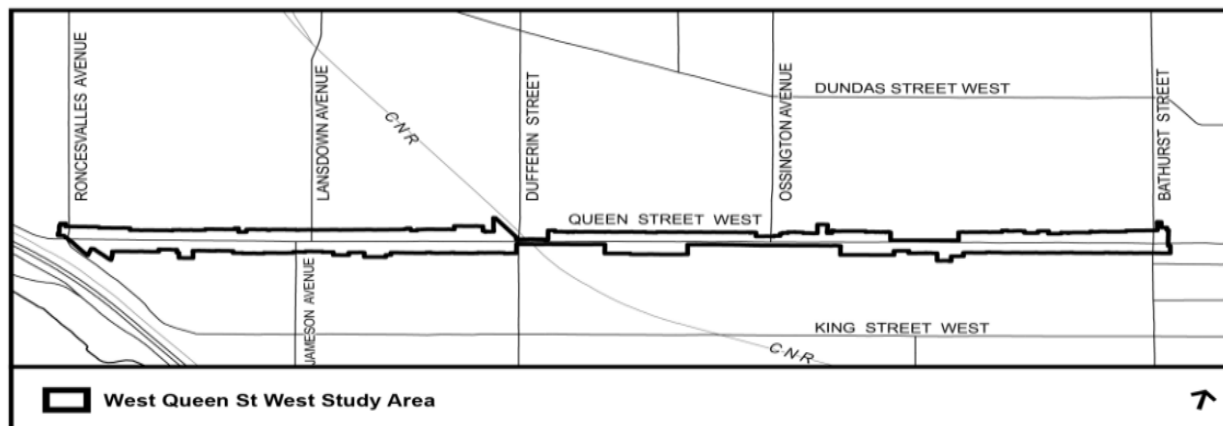


West Queen West Study – Heritage Kick-off Meeting
