Highlights & Service Levels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sorauren Park Fieldhouse now has computer access for staff. • In order to assist with the summer camp waitlist management at Masaryk-Cowan, two new camps were introduced at Holy Family Community Centre with a 91% utilization rate: Pre-Teen and Youth Camps. • There is an increase in demand for Early Years Programs within the ward. An Early Years summer program was introduced at Sorauren for ages 4 and 5 years. • Parkdale Pool is offering a youth swim in August. For more details, contact Christine Silva at 392-6724. • There are 30 children registered in the Masaryk-Cowan After-School Recreation Care fall program and the program is full.

<p>Capital Projects</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masaryk-Cowan Capital Projects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Masaryk-Cowan capital work is comprised of 2 projects – The planned scope of work planned includes the interior improvements to bring Masaryk up to AODA standards. Funds are allocated for design in 2016-2017 with construction slated for 2018-2019. Through the design process, we are hoping that we can integrate the two buildings and unify the programs and spaces into one functioning community centre. – Kitchen #2 – Work completed included the following: Installation of new floors, new stove, minor painting and rekeying of cupboards to accommodate more service providers including Youth Space Initiatives. – Wading pool repainted June 2016. • Minor Upgrades at Sorauren: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Replaced flooring and painted main stairwell. – Installation of the following were completed: window blinds, baby gate leading to basement, change tables and AC.
