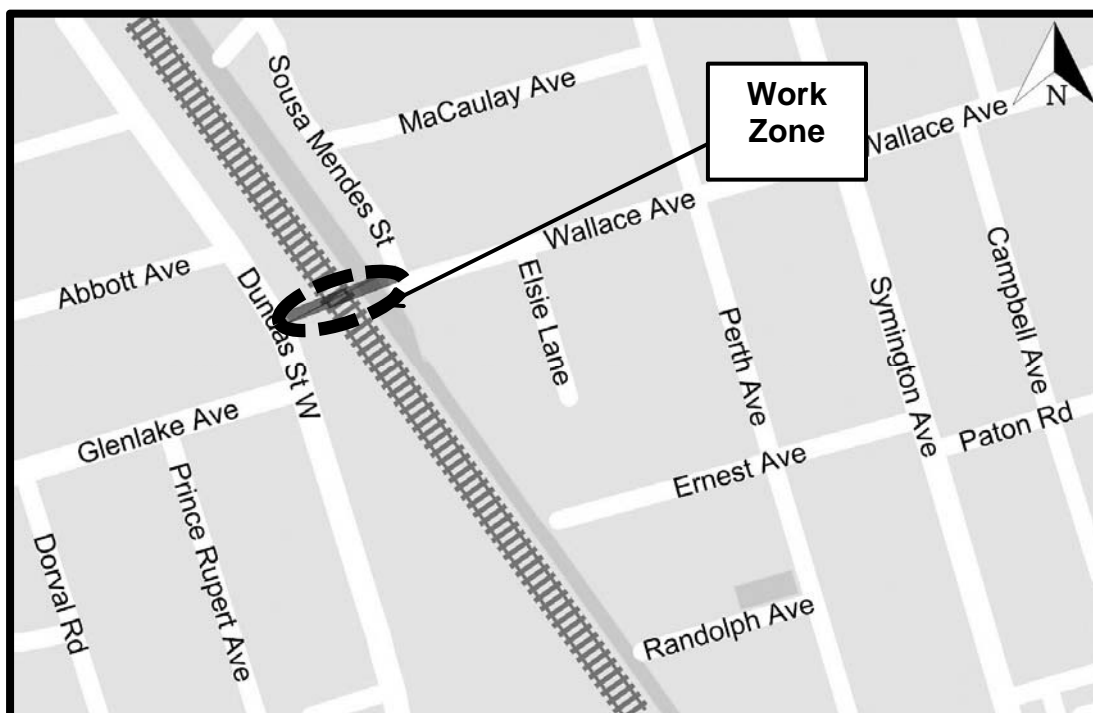
Expected Start Date: November 1, 2016

The contractor working on the Wallace Bridge will be mobilizing on the bridge on November 1, 2016. For this work, the Wallace Avenue Pedestrian Bridge will be closed at night from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. From November 1 to November 4 and November 6 to November 10.

WORK DETAILS





The contractor will:

- Install debris netting system under the west span
- Remove the existing bridge railing on the west and centre span and install temporary railing
- Reinforce the existing truss vertical members
- Replacing the deteriorated timber deck planks and all timber curbs

The contractor will reinforce the existing railing off the site. All locks currently placed on the railing will have to be removed for the planned railing reinforcement.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Nightly Work Hours: 10 pm to 6 am Tuesday, November 1 to Friday, November 4 Monday, November 7 to Thursday November 10 The bridge will not have nightly closures on the weekend (November 4-6).</p>
	<p>Bridge and Pathway Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, the bridge will be closed during the time specified. Pedestrians will have to use Dupont Street or Bloor Street as alternative routes.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Traffic should not be impacted by this work.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored before 6 am every morning for pedestrian access.</p>
