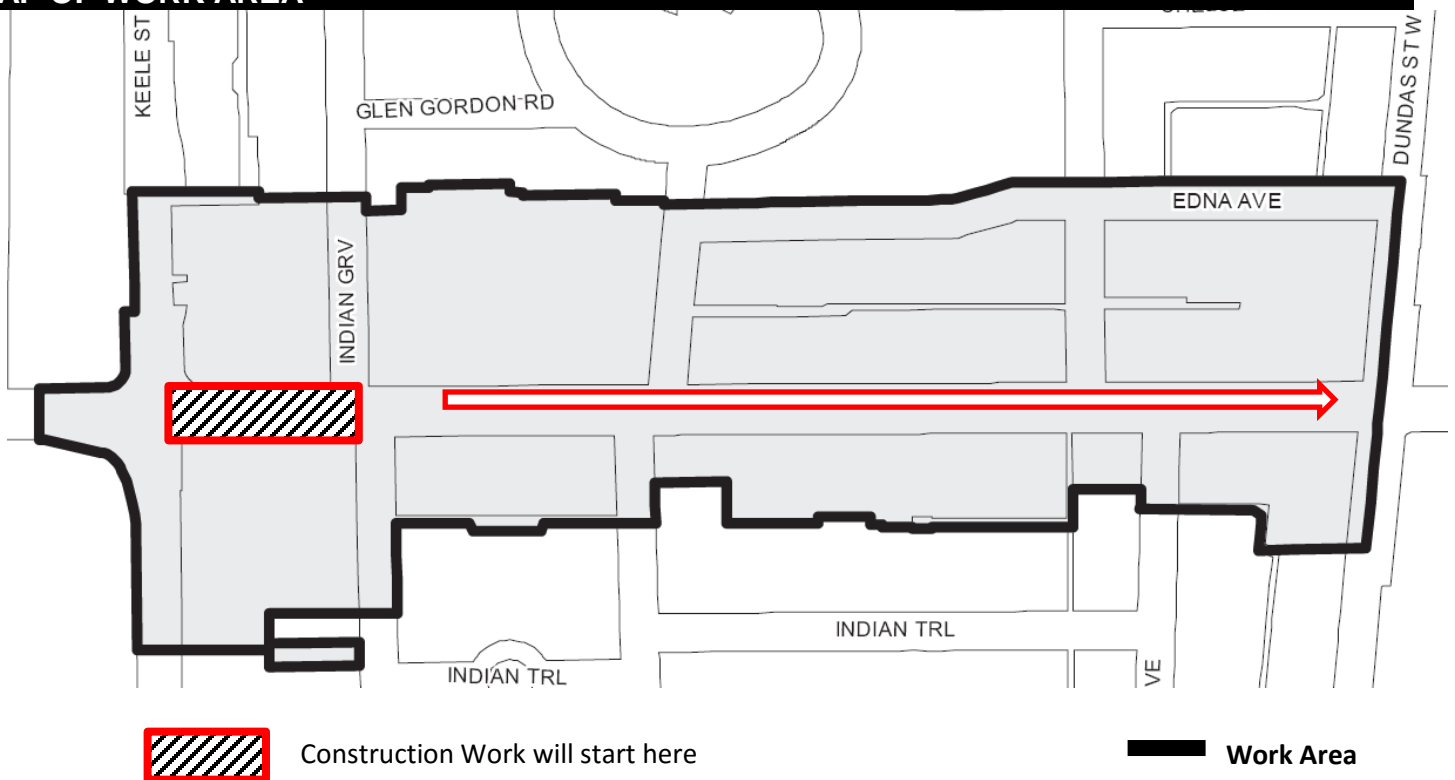
## Street Lighting Improvements on Bloor Street from Keele Street to Dundas Street West

**Expected Start Date: June 12, 2017**  
**Expected End Date: October 10, 2017**

*\*Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.*

The City of Toronto and the Bloor by the Park Business Improvement Area (BIA) is installing pedestrian lighting and underground infrastructure for future Wi-Fi system on Bloor Street West between Keele Street and Dundas Street West. This work will improve the quality of the sidewalk and street environment. The lighting improvements include 19 pedestrian light poles.

### NEW FEATURES:

- Installing 19 new BIA Pedestrian-scale light poles
- Installing underground infrastructure for future Wi-Fi system in the BIA

### CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Work in the boulevard in front of properties is expected. This work includes cutting into the municipal sidewalks.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (sidewalk), such as patio fencing, landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts.
- Access to businesses will be maintained.
- **Construction work is being staged block by block. Work will start on the north side at Keele Street and progress east.**

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Work Hours:</b> crews will work 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday with work on Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., if required.</li> </ul>
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	<p><b>Pre-Construction Photo:</b> The contractor will photograph all properties within the construction area before construction starts. This is important in determining if the construction caused damage. All staff will be wearing photo identification and carrying photographic equipment during their work.</p>
	<p><b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please abide by your regular garbage schedule. Residents and business owners should leave bins out per your regular practice. The Contractor is willing to move bins as necessary to ensure they are picked up by Solid Waste Management.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</p> <p><b>Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your business access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p> <p><b>Emergencies:</b> Report construction-related emergencies immediately to the Construction Contractor's representative on site by calling 311. Also call 311 for water or other road emergencies. Report criminal concerns, health emergencies or fires by calling 911.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management / Parking:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work will occur block by block. Work crews will block the parking in order to maintain road access. There will be no parking where work is taking place.</li> <li>• Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. These efforts include adding Local Access signs.</li> <li>• Traffic on Bloor Street will be reduced to one lane in the work zone. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pedestrians will have to walk around the work area on sidewalks or walkways provided.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cyclists opting to use the sidewalk must dismount and walk the same sections as pedestrians or use alternate routes.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Businesses will be open throughout construction. All from the community are welcome to dine, shop and play.</li> </ul>
