



## High Park Streetcar Loop Parkside Avenue and Howard Park Avenue Field investigation

### What we are doing and why

As part of its State of Good Repair program, in 2020 the TTC will be renewing the tracks on Howard Park Avenue from west of Roncesvalles Avenue to the High Park streetcar loop.

In advance of the track renewal project and as part of the Ravine and Natural Feature Protection application process, TTC will carry out a field investigation inside **High Park Loop** on Sunday, November 24, 2019.

### High Park Loop - equipment

To help better understand ground conditions below and near the existing streetcar track inside the High Park Loop, a high-pressure vacuum and water system mounted on a truck will be used to remove small areas of soil near the track. This method is efficient and quick, and less likely to cause any damage in the area being investigated. Noise will be evident when work is in full operation.

### Work hours

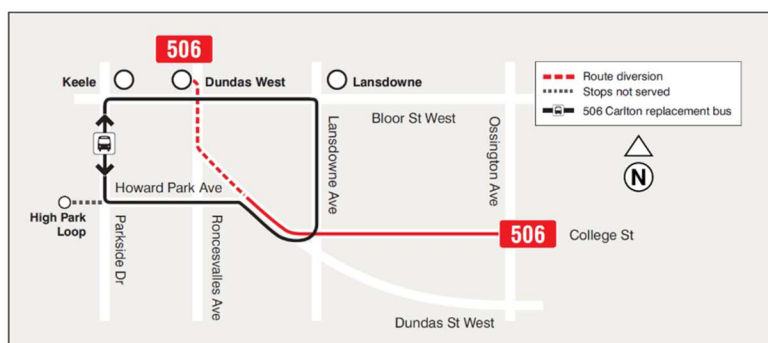
A crew will be onsite on Sunday, November 24 shortly after 7 a.m. for set-up, including performing a power-cut to the overhead streetcar wires. Work will begin at approximately 8 a.m. and continue to approximately 5 p.m.

**506 Carlton shuttle buses** will operate both ways via, Bloor Street West, Lansdowne Avenue, College Street, Dundas Street West, Howard Park Avenue, Parkside Drive and Bloor Street West.
