Background / Proposal

City Planning has proposed for public consultation a draft amendment to the Official Plan and a proposed zoning approach for an amendment to the City-wide Zoning By-law 569-2013 to establish a city-wide approach to public safety for new development of sensitive or high occupancy land uses in proximity to rail infrastructure.
