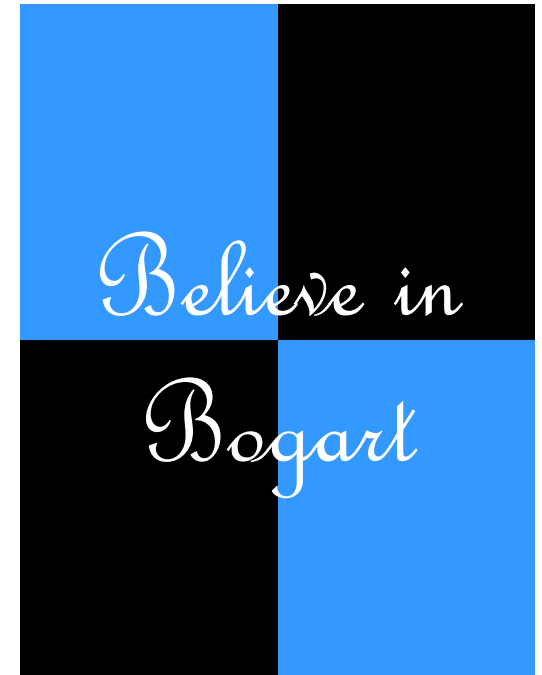

Bogart Mission Statement

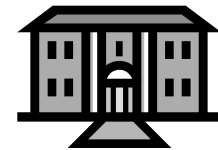

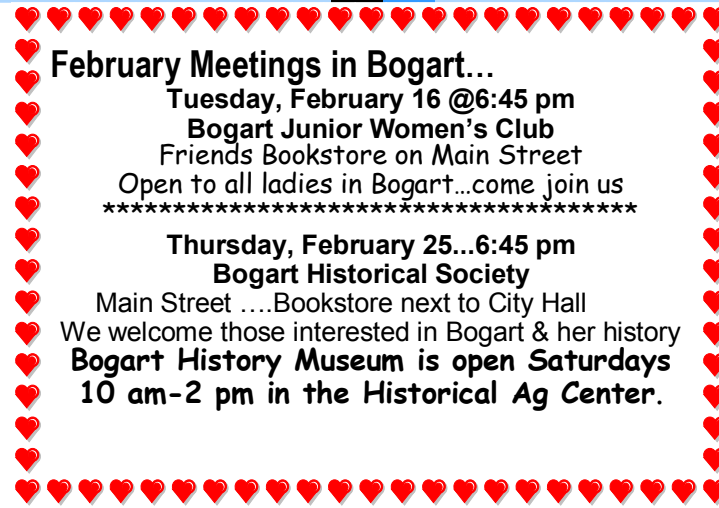
