



NOTICE OF RACE

MYC IOD INVITATIONAL REGATTA

SATURDAY & SUNDAY, MAY 18 & 19, 2019

Organized by the Manhattan Yacht Club

1. PURPOSE OF EVENT: The purpose of the event is to support and promote amateur IOD sailing in the United States by bringing together top IOD sailors.

2. ORGANIZER OF THE EVENT: The organizer of the event is Manhattan Yacht Club.

3. ENTRIES: Six IOD skippers from the IOD Class Fleets will be invited to captain an MYC Member-owned IOD and MYC IOD sailors will serve as crew.

4. RULES: The regatta will be raced according to the International Racing Rules of Sailing as adopted by US Sailing and modified by the Sailing Instructions.

5. YACHTS & EQUIPMENT: This regatta will be raced on IOD sailboats provided by Manhattan IOD owners. The mainsails, jibs and spinnakers, plus sheets and all other equipment will be provided. Teams will rotate boats after each race.

6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Saturday, May 18, 2019

1100 – Skippers Meeting

1200 – Race 1 followed by Races 2 & 3

1700 – Cocktail Party and BBQ at the MYC

Sunday, May 19, 2019

1200 – Race 4 followed by Races 5 & 6

1700 – Awards Ceremony, Cocktail Party and BBQ at the MYC

7. RACING AREA: Races will be held in New York Harbor. All races will start and finish from the Honorable William Wall, Manhattan Yacht Club's floating clubhouse anchored north of Ellis Island.





8. COURSES: Courses will be windward-leeward. Inflatable marks will be set by Race Committee. Because the starting location is fixed, races may start upwind or downwind.

9. CREW: This is an amateur event for IOD sailors. Unlimited crew substitution is allowed during the regatta.

10. SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System will be used. If 5 or more races are completed, each team may discard one race.

11. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded to the top teams, and the Best Sportsman of the Regatta.
