

Spurs Give What'cha Reading Challenge Official Rules

The Spurs What'cha Reading Program presented by Whataburger is a reading/literacy program for students in grades 1–5, designed to improve and encourage a love of reading for kids of all ages throughout San Antonio, and surrounding areas. Students in grades 1–5 are invited to read or be read to and submit their minutes to their teachers or group leaders, who will submit to Spurs Give for a chance to win Spurs and Whataburger swag, Whataburger for lunch for a classroom, or even a virtual event with a Spurs Player for their classroom!

1. No purchase necessary to enter or win. Limit one Entry (defined below) per person.
2. The "Spurs Give Summer What'cha Reading Challenge" ("Sweepstakes") commences on October 19, 2020 at 12:01 a.m. Central Standard Time ("CST") and end on December 2, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. CST. All entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. CST on December 2, 2020 (the "Deadline") to be eligible.
3. Enter by logging onto <https://www.spursgive.org/reading> and fill out the Summer Reading Challenge Form to become an "Entrant" and for a chance to win. Registration opens on October 5, 2020 and ends on October 19, 2020.
4. Eligibility is limited to students in grades 1–5 located in the following areas: any San Antonio schools, classrooms, distance learning groups or organizations; any Austin ISD or Leander ISD schools, classrooms, distance learning groups or organizations; any Kerville ISD schools, classrooms, distance learning groups or organizations.
5. All Entrants must provide valid contact information (i.e., first name, last name, and email address).
5. Completion of an Entry signifies Entrant's acceptance of receiving a sales solicitation from San Antonio Spurs, L.L.C., a Texas limited liability company, d/b/a Spurs Sports & Entertainment ("SS&E") Whataburger ("Sponsor") and/or an authorized Sponsor representative.
6. Student participants shall keep track of minutes read per day. Students shall inform their teacher or group leader of these minutes. The teacher or group leader shall log the student reported minutes on a tracking document provided to them by SS&E. Spurs Give will use the tracking documents to gather data and select winner.
7. SS&E will randomly select three (3) Grand Prize winning Entrants from students with the highest amount of minutes read. Grand Prize Winners will consist of the following:
 - One (1) student from Kerville ISD shall receive one (1) video shoutout from a player, Whataburger for lunch on a date to be determined, and Spurs and Whataburger gear and paraphernalia ("Swag");
 - One (1) student from Austin (including Austin ISD and Leander ISD) shall receive one (1) video shoutout from a player, Whataburger for lunch on a date to be determined, and Swag;
 - One (1) student from San Antonio shall receive one (1) virtual event with a player or special guest, Whataburger for lunch on a date to be determined, and Swag

8. SS&E will randomly select one (1) Grand Prize winning classroom from the San Antonio classrooms with the highest average minutes read. The Grand Prize winning classroom shall receive Whataburger for lunch on a date to be determined by SS&E and Swag.

9. SS&E may also, at their sole discretion, randomly select up to five (5) classrooms to receive Swag.

10. The teacher, librarian, or other group leader of the winning students and/or classrooms shall receive one (1) H.E.B. gift-card with a value of two-hundred dollars (\$200) for school supplies.

11. Winners will be announced on or around December 9, 2020 ("Drawing Date"). Each Prize Winner will be contacted by telephone or e-mail within two (2) days following the Drawing Date.

12. Odds of winning are dependent upon the number of eligible Entries received. Any Prize not claimed will be forfeited. In the event a Prize Winner cannot be contacted within two (2) days, claim the opportunity to win the Prize, or is ineligible to win the Prize, an alternate Prize Winner will be selected through a second random drawing within two (2) days of the original Prize Winner being ruled ineligible.

This Sweepstakes is only open to U.S. residents living in the State of Texas, with the exception of those living within seventy-five (75) miles of the Dallas, Texas and Houston, Texas city limits. Any individuals under the age of eighteen (18) must have a parent or guardian submit an entry on their behalf. Employees, immediate families (spouses, parents, siblings and children) and persons affiliated with Sponsor and its Member Teams, their parent, affiliate and subsidiary companies, are not eligible to enter or win.

21. Entrants that violate the Official Rules are subject to disqualification from participation in the Sweepstakes or claiming or using a Prize. Any such decision is in the sole discretion of SS&E. The potential Prize Winner may be required to execute a Release of Liability within five (5) days of attempted notification.
