AquaCleans for Ponds and Lakes

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

AquaCleans for Ponds and Lakes is supplied either as a loose powder that the end user can measure out, or in a water soluble paper pouch in various sizes to suit the size of pond or lake being treated.

AquaCleans is typically added to a pond or lake once a month, starting in the early spring before the weather warms up and algae becomes a problem, and ending in late fall. In areas that are far enough south that algal control is needed year-round, AquaCleans should be applied throughout the winter months, too.

Application rates are as follows:

Ponds/lakes up to 250,000 gallons (<1 acre feet in volume)	¼ lb of AquaCleans
Ponds/lakes 250,000-500,000 gallons (up to 1.5 acre-feet in volume)	½ lb of AquaCleans
Ponds/lakes 500,000-1,000,000 gallons (up to 4 acre-feet in volume)	1 lb of AquaCleans
Larger—calculate the added amount using the above information as a guide	

When applying AquaCleans in water-soluble paper packets, simply toss the packet away from the shore towards the center of the pond. The water-soluble paper will dissolve within minutes, leaving no residue to be removed.

When applying AquaCleans as a loose powder, sprinkle the product at the mouth of any inflow pipes recharging the pond, or simply dump the powder into the pond as far towards the center as possible (at the end of the dock, etc.) As an alternative, AquaCleans can be slurried in non-chlorinated water and poured out at various points around the periphery of the pond.

AquaCleans will not harm fish, turtles, frogs, or other wildlife.

Because AquaCleans takes time to work, it is not meant to be used in streams or creeks, or in water bodies that have a high rate of discharge.

SPECIAL NOTE: AquaCleans should not be used in conjunction with algaecides. They may negate the effect of AquaCleans.

SAFETY:

- Do not ingest. Do not give packets to small children.
- Dry contents may cause or exacerbate dermatitis, wash skin with soap/water after direct contact.
- In case of eye contact with dry contents, flush eyes with water for 20 minutes, while retracting eyelids.
