GCSE Results Day – 12 August 2021

George Abbot's process for the distribution of Year 10 exam results, as in previous years, will be via the SIMs App and Schoolcomms from 8:30am. Please note that a new SIMs Report will be released to the App, which includes information regarding the weightings of the different evidence sources used in judging subject grades, in addition to the results statement. **Please be aware that the publication of results will not be instant, and it could take a number of hours for these results to be visible on the SIMs App.** Students should only contact the Exams Office if they do not receive their results by midday. Please ensure you can access your SIMs Student/Parent account before we break for the summer holidays. Formal result statements will be distributed to Year 10 on their return to school in September during a nominated tutor time.

Certificates

Certificates will not come into school until around mid-November. Once these have been checked and verified, Year 10 students will receive these during a nominated tutor time.

Appeals

Students who believe they have grounds for appeal upon receiving their results must complete and submit a **Stage 1 Centre Appeal** form electronically to exams@georgeabbot.surrey.sch.uk by **16 August 2021**. Following the submission of a Stage 1 Centre Review, students will be sent the Centre Outcome of their appeal electronically. Students who remain dissatisfied with this outcome must complete and submit a **Stage 2 Appeal** form electronically to exams@georgeabbot.surrey by **20 August 2021**. All Stage 2 Appeals will be submitted to the relevant Exam Board. Any form received after this date risks not being dealt with by the Exam Boards in a timely manner.

The Exam Boards will send the outcome of the Stage 2 Appeal back to Centres. The Exams Office will send this outcome to the students electronically.
