

## LESSON SNAPSHOT

**BOTTOM LINE:**

God wants us to stand up for what's right.

**OBJECTIVE:**

Kids will learn how they can take a stand for God.

**KEY PASSAGE:**

Daniel 3:8-30, The Fiery Furnace

**MEMORY VERSE:**

*"Neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:39 (NIV)*

**SUMMARY:**

Having no spine (or any bones at all), the jellyfish flops through the sea. Kids will learn that God doesn't want us to flop around when it comes to doing what's right.

**SIMPLE PRAYER:**

*Dear God,*

*Give us the courage to stand up for what is right.*

*In Jesus' name,*

*Amen*

**MAKE IT STICK:**

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids what peer pressures they've seen in school. Ask them how hard it is to stand up and do the right thing when their friends are doing the opposite. Pray with them to have the courage to stand up for what's right?

**PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

Standing up for what's right means more than defending your faith or facing bullies. It means doing the right thing when everyone else is making poor choices. Pray for all of our kids to stand strong in the face of peer pressure and lean on God to help them do the right thing.
