

LESSON SNAPSHOT

BOTTOM LINE:

Jesus paid the price for our sins.

OBJECTIVE:

Kids will learn that God's laws show that we cannot be perfect like God in our own strength. That is why a sacrifice for sins was required.

KEY PASSAGE:

Exodus 20:1-17, The Ten Commandments

MEMORY VERSE:

"He determines the number of the stars and calls them each by name. Great is our Lord and mighty in power; His understanding has no limit." Psalm 147:4-5 (NIV)

SUMMARY:

The Israelites wanted to follow God, but they were lawless and without direction. God showed His great love to them by giving them His commandments so they would know what is required to be faithful and righteous.

SIMPLE PRAYER:

Dear God,

Thank you for sending Jesus to die for us.

MAKE IT STICK:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask the kids to try and list how many rules you have in your house, written or unwritten. Then ask them how the 10 Commandments are God's rules for life.

PARENT TIME:
