

Waterfront Thank You Card Tutorial



Paper

Flirty Flamingo Card stock (141416): Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4" and fold

Rich Razzleberry Card stock (115316): Cut 3 3/4" x 5"

Whisper White Card stock (100730): Cut 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"

Rich Razzleberry Card stock (115316): Cut 2 5/8" x 2 5/8"

Whisper White Card stock (100730): Cut 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Whisper White Card stock (100730): Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

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Assembly:

1. Adhere the Rich Razzleberry Card stock to card front.
2. Use a little Snail Adhesive on the back of the small piece of Whisper White Card stock and tack it in place onto the piece of Whisper White card stock. Centering it about ½" down from the top. (This piece will be removed in step 16 so do not adhere it down tightly.)
3. Begin your stamping by using the Rich Razzleberry Classic Ink to stamp the mountain range on the left side of layered card stock. (It is ok if there is a little missing where the pieces meet since the mat will cover this.)
4. Next stamp the sentiment in the lower right-hand corner in Rich Razzleberry Classic Ink.
5. Stamp the long image to create the sand in Crumb Cake Classic Ink onto the right side of the layered card stock about 2/3 of the way down.
6. Next stamp the palm tree trunks in Crumb Cake Classic Ink.
7. Stamp the palms in Call Me Clover Classic Ink.
8. Now stamp the little hut in Flirty Flamingo Classic Ink. Remove the roof using the Blender Pen. Clean the Blender Pen by running it on your Grid Paper until all the color is gone.
9. Use the Call Me Clover Stampin' Write Marker and color the roof of the hut. "Breathe" on the image to moisten the ink and stamp on the sand under palm trees.
10. Stamp the large "swash" image in Bermuda Bay Classic Ink. Stamp off and then stamp onto Whisper White card stock under the island.
11. Stamp the "zig zag" water image in Bermuda Bay Classic Ink and stamp below the mountains. Repeat without reinking to get a lighter shade.
12. Repeat again a few times as desired to create water, stamping off to create different shades of blue.
13. Stamp the sun image using Crushed Curry Classic Ink.
14. Then ink the dot image using Crushed Curry Classic ink, first around the sun and then to the right of the sentiment and the left of the sentiment. Clean stamp.
15. Ink dot image again this time using Bermuda Bay and stamp on the water by the Crushed Curry dots.
16. Remove the smaller Whisper White layer from the larger one by breathing on the back to loosen the adhesive.
17. Adhere this piece to the Rich Razzleberry card stock and then adhere it back into place on the larger piece.
18. Adhere the layered panel to the card front.
19. Stamp the inside Whisper White panel as desired and adhere.
20. Decorate your Whisper White Envelope as desired.
