Weill Cornell Medical College engaged BGA for a number of architectural projects, over the course of 20 years. This most recent project entailed the full renovation of the Education Center, designed to be completed over the short summer break between semesters.

Project features include:



- Renovation of (20) Classrooms with a mix of ‘Wet’ and ‘Dry’ Labs, incorporating State of the Art teaching resources, including hi-resolution Displays + Monitors for Digital Microscopy
- Development of reconfigurable furniture layouts for the Classrooms, based on mobile tables and seating. These allow the Professors to easily change the classroom configuration to facilitate the teaching method best suited to their curriculum
- The design of new Lighting Layouts based on LED light sources, consistent with the College’s energy-conservation goals
- The addition, for Acoustical purposes, of suspended ceilings and vibration isolators on the new HVAC equipment, to minimize sound transmission between classrooms
- Analysis + Review of Educational Furniture products with the College’s Steering Committee, and the specifications of Seating, Tables and Lockers to complement the new design
