- Reconfiguration of 2,200 SF Lab space to accommodate staff growth and new medical technology to meet technical requirements of the College's recent Grant assignment
- Modification to the partition layout
- Multiple Labs incorporating new laboratory equipment, consisting of Fume Hoods, a Tissue Culture Room and a Microscope Room
- Addition of Private Offices for the research staff
- Replacement of all the lighting with newer, energy-efficient Fluorescent fixtures, consistent with the College's energy-conservation goals and design standards
