



Good Morning,

Despite, the Federal Government distributing economic stimulus checks for over two months, we have heard that many eligible clients still haven't received a payment.

Most payments will be deposited directly into your bank account. Those not deposited electronically will be sent through the mail as a paper check or prepaid debit card. Payments will come via the normal US mail and may appear to be junk mail making them easily missed. If you are being sent a check or debit card, you will receive a plain white envelope from Money Network Cardholder Services (see picture below).

Payments will continue to be sent through September and the government has said that over 35 million payments are still to be made, so not having received a payment yet doesn't mean you won't. Remember that married/joint filers earning over \$198,000 (based on 2018 or 2019 income) won't receive payments.
