A not frequently explored holiday tale, Krampus is a figure in European folklore, which during the Christmas season punishes children who have misbehaved. This folklore contrasts with Saint Nicholas, who rewards the well behaved with gifts. Students will be introduced to this folklore character and by using mixed media, will create a painting (or drawing) of their own holiday character. He does not have to be scary; he could merely be overly mischievous like the Elf on the shelf... but geared towards the teen imagination. Creating their "own" version of Krampus- Students will be able to reflect their own family traditions into their creations and have a unique piece of art in the end. Supplies included.

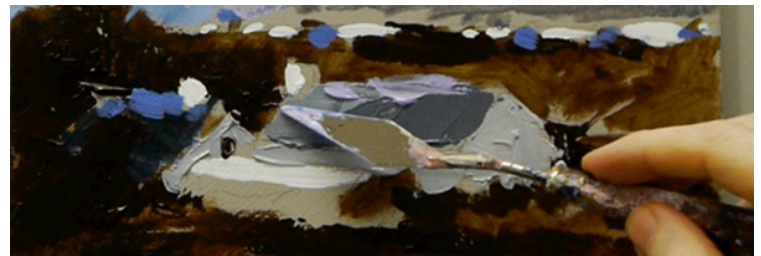
ADVANCED ACRYLIC AND OIL PAINTING WITH THE PALETTE KNIFE
