

RPRC Match Description:

Rifle – Military Rifles – 100yds

OPTICS & OPEN Sights Divisions

This match consists of two “divisions”. Only one match score will be counted toward the Rifle and Club Championship.

TARGETS: 2 NRA SR-1, 10 shots per target.

GUNS: Any issued Center-fire Military Rifle or commercial equivalent rifle

SIGHTS: Two Separate Divisions: One Division for Open/standard iron sights for the issued rifle and an Optics Division for any sights other than open sights.

SLINGS: A sling can be attached to the rifle and may be used as specified for a specific Course-of-Fire.

ACCESSORIES: Except for support mechanisms, other accessories may be used, such a shooting coat and spotting scopes.

COURSE-OF-FIRE:

UNLIMITED sight-in shots in 5 minutes from any position

Standing Slow-fire (No Sling Use): 10 Shots in 10 minutes.

Standing Rapid Fire (Hasty Sling only): Two separate 5 Shot strings in 30 seconds each.
Sling strap may wrap around the arm (no arm loop).

SCORING:

Combined Maximum Score Possible of 200.

A winner will be declared for each division.

Ties will be broken by the number of X's, and if necessary, a single shot shoot-off in the standing position with the winner being the closest to the bulls-eye center.
