

## RPRC Tyro Competition Course of Fire 2021

These rules are a modification of the NRA rules to develop competition skill. All RPRC range rules will be adhered to.

The match will count BOTH in the Pistol Division of the Club Championship and in the Overall Club Championship.

There will be one center fire competition, and one Rim fire competition.

Match will be held on the 25-yard range.

There will be a **mandatory** match briefing 15 minutes prior to the match to review safety and course of fire.

Total of 24 shots.

TARGETS: ● NRA AP-1 targets, 3 yards apart edge-to-edge, 10 yards from the firing line.

EQUIPMENT: ● GUNS: Any Pistol adhering to range rules

● SIGHTS: Any sights, except sights projecting an image on the target (Lasers) are prohibited.

● TRIGGERS: Release triggers are prohibited.

Revolvers or semi-automatic handguns are permitted. Guns will be loaded with no more than 6 rounds for each stage of firing (There is a 6 round reload in stage 3).

COURSE OF FIRE: Competitors must fire all stages in the standing position starting from low - ready position.

This course is divided into three (3) stages. All firing will be done at 10 yards. 24 shots total.

- Stage 1 – total 6 shots, 3 strings each 2 shots in 5 seconds
  - String 1 - 2 shots in 5 seconds, Center Target
  - String 2 - 2 shots in 5 seconds, Left Target
  - String 3 - 2 shots in 5 seconds, Right Target
- Stage 2 – total 6 shots, 1 string in 8 seconds
  - 2 shots at each target, shoot targets in any order

- Stage 3 – total 12 shots, 1 string (2 magazines, or speed loaded, loaded with 6 shots ) in 20 seconds
  - 2 shots at each target, any order
    - RELOAD –
    - 2 additional shots at each target, any order
- Ties broken by number of X's
