

DEFINITION OF “PROHIBITED PERSON”

Under the Firearms Act 1996 (Victoria), you are a prohibited person if:

- *You are serving a term of imprisonment;*
- *You have completed a term of imprisonment of 5 years or more within the last 15 years;*
- *You have completed a term of imprisonment of less than 5 years within the last 5 years;*
- *You are subject to an intervention order or a corresponding order made in another State;*
- *You are subject to a community based order;*
- *You are subject to a supervision order;*
- *You were subject to an intervention order, community based order, or supervision order within the last 5 years; or*
- *You have been convicted of a firearms offence or an indictable offence within the last 12 months;*

unless you are deemed not to be a prohibited person by virtue of a court order.

If you are a prohibited person you must not handle firearms or apply for membership of a pistol club.
