COVID and In-person worship @ Trinity — Sunday @ 8 AM

This week, Bishop Patrick Bell and the Diocesan Council met. Until further notice, all participants in Diocesan events and parish gatherings must be fully and properly masked until further notice. Bishop Pat strongly recommends that everyone be fully vaccinated as soon as possible.

Here are a few details about in-person worship @ 8 am:

- The liturgy is relatively simple, and slightly briefer than otherwise. Communion is offered in one kind.
- Wear a mask while indoors. Observe physical distancing and discourage physical interactions.
- If you are immunocompromised, likely to be more susceptible to COVID for any reason, or are not feeling well, please take care of yourself and join the 10 am online service.
- Childcare is not provided. The noise of children is welcome.
- We strongly encourage everyone to be vaccinated, but we are not requiring proof of vaccination.
- There's not an organized social hour following worship, but you are free to gather outdoors informally in front of Trinity after worship. (Bring your own coffee or tea.) We recommend keeping your mask on.

The pandemic continues to be an enormous challenge for us all. Thank you for the support you have given.
