- Wear a mask whether indoors or out. Observe physical distancing and discourage physical interactions.
- If you are immunocompromised, likely to be more susceptible to COVID for any reason, or are not feeling well, please stay home and take care of yourself. Please join the 10 am online service.
- You are free to gather outdoors informally in front of Trinity after worship. (Bring your own coffee or tea.) Masks are required in groups outdoors.
