The following is a recommended script for new net controllers.

1. QST QST QST This is the **<YOUR CALL SIGN>**, **<NAME>** net control for the weekly **<NET NAME>** Golden Triangle Amateur Radio Club net, using the club call letters W6GTR.
2. This is a directed net. Please address all traffic through net control. Emergency traffic may break in at any time. IS THERE ANY EMERGENCY TRAFFIC? **<BRIEF PAUSE>**
3. Check-Ins will be taken in alphabetical order using the first letter of the suffix of your call letters. Use phonetics of your suffix to assist net control. Check-Ins will be followed by 2 rounds of round table discussion. **<IF APPLICABLE>**
4. **<2 METER NET ONLY>** Before starting Check-Ins, we will call Judy, NB6J for any announcements to the net. NB6J go ahead. **<PAUSE FOR JUDY'S ANNOUNCEMENTS>**. Thank you, Judy.
5. Ask if there are any other announcements. Birthdays, Anniversaries, etc.
6. We will now begin Check-Ins for suffixes beginning with the letter's A to E. **<PAUSE FOR CHECK-INS>**, log them in on the roster, pause, then acknowledge each Check-In by call letters and name, if you like in proper order). **<LEAVE ROOM FOR ECHOLINK CHECKINS>**
7. Repeat step 6 for letters F to K, and again for letters L through Z.
8. Last call for members not checked in or any visitors; Check-In now please.
9. We will now start our round table discussion of any comments, questions, news or stories for the net. Let's start with ----

INSTRUCTION: after the first round, you may call for late or missed Check-Ins again. Don't forget to take a turn yourself at the proper time. Remember, that for the net to work well you will need to control it. This practice is important training in painlessly adapting to controlled net environment that is very important if we are ever too effective in an emergency situation.

10. After the 2nd round of comments, etc., call one last time for any late or missed Check-Ins by members or visitors. If there are any, give them a turn, if none then... "We wish to thank all of you for your participation in tonight's net and look forward to seeing you all again next week. This is **<YOUR CALL SIGN>**, **<NAME>** for the W6GTR **<DAY>** **<NET NAME>**, closing at (TIME PST) with a 73 to all."
