Our Worship

We have a **Torah Service** at 10:30am on Saturdays for around 30 minutes with most of our Jewish liturgy. The Mourner's Kaddish gives those who are grieving or remembering the loss of a loved one to sanctify God's name. (Let us know in advance if you would like us to acknowledge that on a given Saturday.) During the **Shabbat Celebration Service** (after the Torah Service) we have the Sh'ma with V'ahavta, singing, and a message from the Scriptures.

Worshipping Through Giving

The offerings are put in the offering box in the back of the sanctuary and are expected only from believers in Yeshua (Jesus). Seekers concerning Yeshua are just our guests. If you want a tax deductible record of your giving, then indicate cash gifts on an involvement/prayer card. We will see the amount of giving on your checks. Also, write any prayer requests on the back of the prayer cards and put them in the offering box as well.

At the Conclusion of the Service

Blessings for the Oneg and the Lord's Supper

Blessing over the Bread (Ha-Motzi): *Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha-olam, ha-motzi lechem min-ha-aretz. Amen (Blessed art Thou, O Lord our God, King of the Universe, Who brings forth bread from the earth. Amen.)*

Blessing over the Cup (Kiddush): *Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha-olam, borei p'ri ha-gafen. Amen. (Blessed art Thou, O Lord our God, King of the Universe, Creator of the fruit of the vine. Amen.)*

HOW TO HAVE ETERNAL LIFE WITH GOD (DANIEL 12:2)

1. **Accept that you are spiritually separated from God due to sin** (*Psalm 14:2-3; Ecclesiastes 7:20; Isaiah 59:1-2; 64:6*)
2. **Believe God gave His Son, Messiah Yeshua (Jesus), to die to atone for your sins** (*Leviticus 4:27-31; 17:11; Psalm 2; Proverbs 30:4; Isaiah 9:6-7; 52:13 - 53:12; Zechariah 12:10*)
3. **Repent and trust Messiah Yeshua as your Lord to forgive your sins and give you eternal life** (*Genesis 15:6; Psalm 2:12; 110:1; Isaiah 1:18; 28:16; 53:4-6, 10; 55:6-7; Jeremiah 31:31-34; John 3:16; 14:6; Romans 10:9-13*)
