1 Kings 21: 25-29

<sup>25</sup> (There was none who sold himself to do what was evil in the sight of the LORD like Ahab, whom Jezebel his wife incited. <sup>26</sup> He acted very abominably in going after idols, as the Amorites had done, whom the LORD cast out before the people of Israel.)

<sup>27</sup> And when Ahab heard those words, he tore his clothes and put sackcloth on his flesh and fasted and lay in sackcloth and went about dejectedly. <sup>28</sup> And the word of the LORD came to Elijah the Tishbite, saying, <sup>29</sup> “Have you seen how Ahab has humbled himself before me?
