

## **FIRST AID:**

In the event that first aid is required to be administered during an activity, all persons attending to the injured individual must first put on a mask and gloves to be provided by the club. First Aid kit and defibrillator will be stored in the locker room.

## **THE PROTOCOL:**

- **SOCIAL DISTANCING MANDATORY, 2 meters between players at all times**
  - Jacks will **not** be provided. Please bring your own ball. **No fruit!!** The player who brings the ball is the only one to place or roll it. EG: tennis balls, pool balls, golf balls.
  - Benches are off limits  
  
Mats will **not** be provided. Bring your own towel to use in place of the mat if desired
  - Rakes are **not** to be used. Use your feet to move your own bowls. Do not touch other players bowls
  - No scoreboards, water buckets or hoses are to be used. If you need to wet your towel you must bring your own water in a sealed container. Please bring labeled water bottle if desired.
  - Your own disinfectant wipes, masks and gloves are recommended
  - Everything you bring into the green you must take out
  - Leave quickly as soon as your session is over
  - \$1 to be collected by coordinator at beginning of each session. **NO CHANGE.** Container will be put on sanitizer/form table at Dolphin Street entrance at the beginning of the day and the coordinator, for the last session, will put away.

## **CLUB HOUSE:**

- Clubhouse and washrooms are off limits and cannot be used except in an emergency and will have to be disinfected immediately if used for any reason. Coordinators are to ensure all rules are strictly adhered to.
- If an outbreak should occur affecting any club members, all club activities will be suspended until the cause of the outbreak has been determined and corrective procedures have been documented and implemented. The Club will remain closed until safe to re-open

## **RULES WILL BE POSTED**

This situation is very fluid and Rules and Regulations will be updated as required. As mentioned above, it is impossible to try and come up with a protocol for everything that could happen and it is a learning experience for all of us. The most important thing I want every member to be aware of is "you are responsible for your own actions and decisions". The only thing the club can do is make it as safe as possible, following the guide lines from the City of White Rock and Bowls BC. There are lots of things that we may have to change or adjust as we go. This is just a start.
