

Six anglers fished the October club tournament at Roosevelt Lake on Saturday the 17th and Sunday the 18th. We fished from safe light, approximately 6:05am) till 3:00pm on Saturday and 1:00pm on Sunday. The lake was at 83% fill and the water temps ranged from around 68 to 73 depending on location and time of day. The river proved to be the hotspot for Ken Landry. Ken caught a weighed 10 keepers for a total of 18.81# for the two days. He caught big fish for Saturday (3.76#) and Sunday (3.37#). Ken advised he had to wade through many short fish to get to his keepers. Several came on topwater but most were on crankbaits. Jim Davis led the field of non-boaters...the field....consisted of Jim and Bill Pfeifer. Jim weighed a total of 11.78# for the two days. The major shock here was that the majority of Jim's fish came on crankbaits on Sunday...nary a dropshot!! Jim fished with Ken on Sunday and they found a honey hole in the river that was loaded with shad. They took that spot to the bank. Well done Ken and Jim...congratulations. Angelo Messina also weighed 10 keepers for both days; no details on how though. Angelo came in second for the tournament. Well done Angelo!!
