**DECLARATION No. 2020-D01**

A DECLARATION OF THE CITY OF WOLFFORTH,  
TEXAS, DECLARING A DISASTER FOR THE CITY OF  
WOLFFORTH.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Wolfforth on the 23rd day of March, 2020, has determined that there is an imminent threat of injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

The novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus and 10 cases have been confirmed in Lubbock County, Texas and 566 cases in Texas, and cases are expected to increase.

**WHEREAS,** the Mayor of Wolfforth has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate and prevent the suffering of people and to protect property; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, BY THE MAYOR OF WOLFFORTH:**

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Wolfforth pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.


Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Wolfforth.

Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary


Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
