

Daryl Nasby called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

1. The minutes of the April 29, 2014 meeting were read. There were no errors or omissions. Karen Rivard moved her minutes be adopted as read. Lyle Nasby seconded. Carried.
2. Financials. The proposed budget was examined. It was decided that the current lawn mower is fine. There were several minor questions for clarification, for example: admin costs, power bills, transportation, etc. No issues arose from these questions.
3. Recycle bins. Karen read the letter concerning recycle bins that we received from the R.M. Evelyn explained that fewer containers are needed because recyclables are machine sorted in Edmonton.
4. Water. We have not heard from Tec Water since they came in and ran the tests on our system last August. So, we are assuming that something major happened with their company. Therefore, we are back to the beginning with regards exploration of our options for improvement of our water.
5. Garbage. There was discussion once again about how we might control who uses our dumpsters. We must stay vigilant and confront anyone we see from outside the Hamlet. We decided to put a lid on the garbage can beside the mailboxes. Paper carriers will be asked to look after their own leftover papers instead of putting them in the garbage can.
6. Houses to be condemned. We were updated as to why nothing has been done with the house that has been condemned. Also, it was determined that we need to write letters asking that two other properties be condemned. Those properties are located on lots 16 and 21.
7. Dogs running. It was suggested to residents that when they see dogs running, they contact the SPCA.
8. Playground. Rachel Mitchell requested that a playground be developed. We suggested that she strike a committee to operate under the umbrella of the Hamlet.
9. Lyle Nasby brought up drainage. He and Darren Millard will look into it.
10. Clean-up. The annual clean-up will be on May 14. Darren will make sure bags are available. We will meet at Mitchell's at 7:00 p.m.

11. There was discussion about the use of ATV's around the Hamlet. Several residents use ATV's as their mode of transportation around town, and they are not a problem. Therefore we do not want a by-law. Underage drivers, and drivers who are stunting should be reported.
