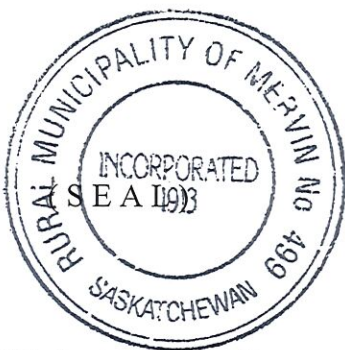


## BYLAW #2014-02

### A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MERVIN #499 TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Mervin No. 499, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Civic Addressing Bylaw.
2. A uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings is hereby established and is shown on the attached maps identified as Schedule "A", appended hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. A separate number shall be assigned for each of the following frontages:
  - a. Lakeshore Development Districts:
    - i. Commercial uses: 7.5 metres (25 feet)
    - ii. Residential uses: 18 metres (60 feet)
    - iii. All other uses: 15 metres (50 feet)
  - b. Hamlet Districts:
    - i. Commercial uses: 7.5 metres (25 feet)
    - ii. Residential uses: 30 metres (98.4 feet)
    - iii. All other uses: 15 metres (50 feet)
4. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated, and each number shall have a minimum height of five (5) inches.
5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this bylaw, upon request of the owner of a property situated on a corner, the number assigned may be assigned to the side of the house facing the site frontage.
6. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear a separate number.
7. Numericals indicated the official number of each house or building or each front entrance shall be posted in a manner as to be clearly visible from the street on which the property is located.
8. The Municipal Planner shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw shall be held at the RM of Mervin No. 499 office.
9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable as per the General Penalty Schedule.
10. All existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming to the provision of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
11. This bylaw shall come into effect on January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014.
