



Protocols and Procedures for Joyful Twirlers 2020-2021 Season

General Procedures

- Twirlers will not be permitted to participate in practice until the following forms/fees have been completed and submitted:
 1. Registration form and fee
 2. Activity Participation Agreement
 3. Participation Waiver
 4. Protocols and Procedures Form
- Masks must be worn by all twirlers (and anyone 2 years of age and older who enters the building for any reason) at ALL times. If practicing outside, masks may be removed once twirlers are placed in a spot that is a minimum of 6 feet apart from other twirlers. Masks must be put back on once a twirler leaves their assigned spot for any reason.
- Masks must be properly fitted, covering both the twirler's nose and mouth. Gaiter style masks are not permitted.
- Temperature checks will be done upon arrival. If a twirler has a temperature above 99.9, the twirler will not be allowed to attend practice and will be required to return home immediately (Parents, please do not leave until your child's temperature has been taken).
- Hand sanitizer will be administered to each twirler upon entering the building.
- Twirlers will be physically distanced at least 6 feet while practicing (*this is standard procedure anyway due to the nature of baton twirling*). Twirlers will be assigned a "spot" in the practice space and must remain in that spot for the duration of the class.
- Twirlers should bring their own water bottles marked with their names.
- No more than 25 people may occupy the fellowship hall (practice space), or lobby, at any given time. This includes twirlers, coaches, and family members.
- Parents who wish to sit and watch the practice session are welcome to do so but must inform Gina **prior to the day of the lesson** in order to ensure that we do not exceed the 25-person capacity.
- Parents who wish to sit and watch practice are asked to bring their own chairs to reduce the need for sanitizing of chairs between classes. Chairs must be spaced 6 feet apart (unless sitting with immediate family members).
- There can be no congregating of friends (children or adults).
- If a twirler has traveled out of state, they must quarantine for 14 days before returning to practice.
- All twirlers must use their own baton. Twirlers should not handle any baton(s) other than their own.
- Monthly birthday celebrations will be suspended until further notice. We also ask that no treats (for any celebration/holiday) be brought to class to be shared.

Arrival

- Doors will open no more than 10 minutes prior to the start of class.
- If not staying for class, parents should pull up to the main doors to drop off their twirler(s). Cars should form a line, pull up to the main doors, and drop off one at a time.
- Masks should be on when twirlers exit their vehicles, prior to entering the building.
- A volunteer will perform temperature checks and administer hand sanitizer as twirlers enter the building. **Parents, please do not drive away until the temperature check is done.**
- Once inside, twirlers must maintain a 6-foot distance from one another in the lobby until their class begins.
- The main doors will be locked at 15 minutes after the hour. If you arrive more than 15 minutes late for class, pull up to the first door past the main entrance and knock. A volunteer or coach will let you in.

Dismissal

- When arriving to pick up your child, we ask that you make the first right into the LOWER parking lot (not the upper lot where you drop off for arrival), pull around the far side of the church and stop when you get to the upper parking lot. We will be exiting using the fellowship hall door closest to that side of the building. Cars should form a line. At the end of class, we will open the door and cars can begin to pull up one at a time and we will dismiss your twirler.
- A volunteer will be posted at the door and twirlers will be dismissed from their spot on the floor to retrieve their belongings one at a time as parents arrive.
