Dear Residents, Family Members, Resident Guardians, and Supporters of Homme Home,

During the week of May 18, 2020 Homme Home's Wittenberg campus was provided COVID testing supplies from the State of Wisconsin to test residents and staff. We conducted testing that week and tests were sent to the State of Wisconsin's lab on Friday May 22, 2020. The test results were provided on Wednesday May 27, 2020 and all tests were resulted negative for COVID.

Even though we have not had positive cases of COVID we are required to follow guidance from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and the Department of Health Services. Per their guidance Homme must continue to restrict visitors to our care centers, with the exception of end of life care.

During this time, we encourage you to utilize technology to have a "virtual visit" with any resident of Homme Home. We have put in place multiple platforms for family members and loved ones to connect with our residents. For assistance with "virtual visits" please contact our activities staff at the main number of Homme Home or Forest Park Village.

COVID 19 is still prevalent in Wisconsin as well as Shawano County and Marathon County. Please practice social distancing and personal hygiene when out in the community.
