Dear Residents, Family Members, Resident Guardians, and Supporters of Homme Home,

We are alerting you that we completed another round of mandated employee testing for COVID-19 on our Wittenberg Campus. All test results were received, and 1 test came back positive. This staff person is asymptomatic, meaning they are not showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

We continue to work with Shawano County Department of Public Health to ensure we are taking the correct steps to maintain our residents' safety.

As it relates to the positive COVID-19 Staff cases that we have experienced over the last three weeks, two of the staff have recovered and two staff are considered active.

Our employees are following infection control protocols and are wearing appropriate personal protective equipment. In addition to screening at Homme, employees are directed to monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 when not at work.

We also continue to monitor all residents three times daily for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.

To date this is the following level of COVID-19 at Homme Home of Wittenberg Campus:
