Dear Residents, Family Members, Resident Guardians, and Supporters of Homme Home,

We are alerting you that we have completed another round of mandatory employee COVID-19 testing during the week of August 24, 2020. We have received all test results, and all tests were negative. As of today, there are no active employee COVID-19 cases at Homme.

We continue to work with Shawano County Department of Public Health to ensure we are taking the correct steps to maintain our residents' safety.

Our employees are following infection control protocols and are wearing appropriate personal protective equipment. In addition to screening at Homme, employees are directed to monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 when not at work.

We also continue to monitor all residents three times daily for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
